

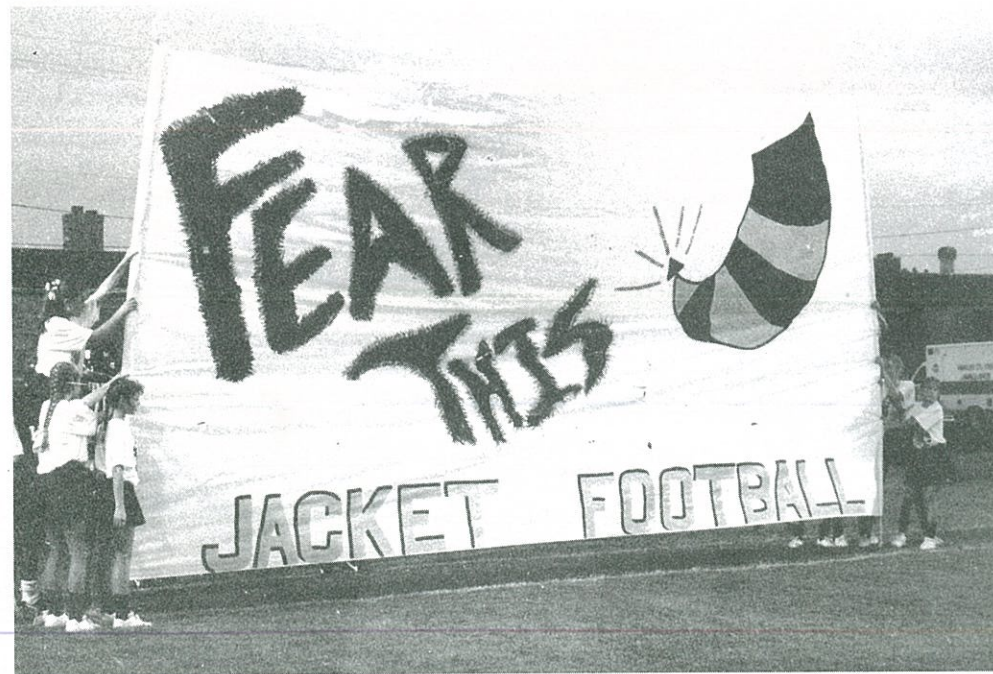
# Freshman squad adds talent to KHS

Mycah Emmerson, Macy Walker, and Nicole Trammell boost spirit at pep rally.

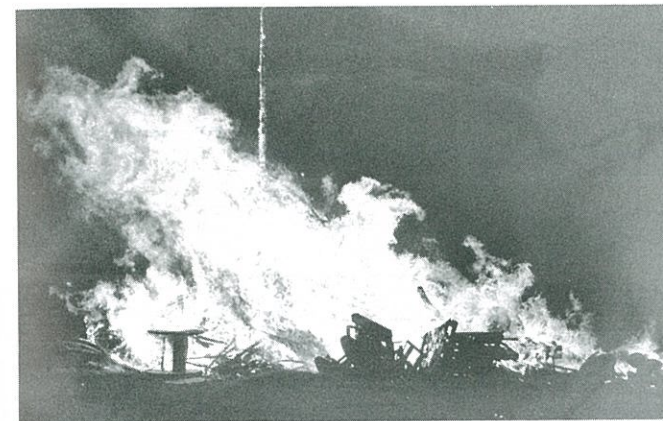
