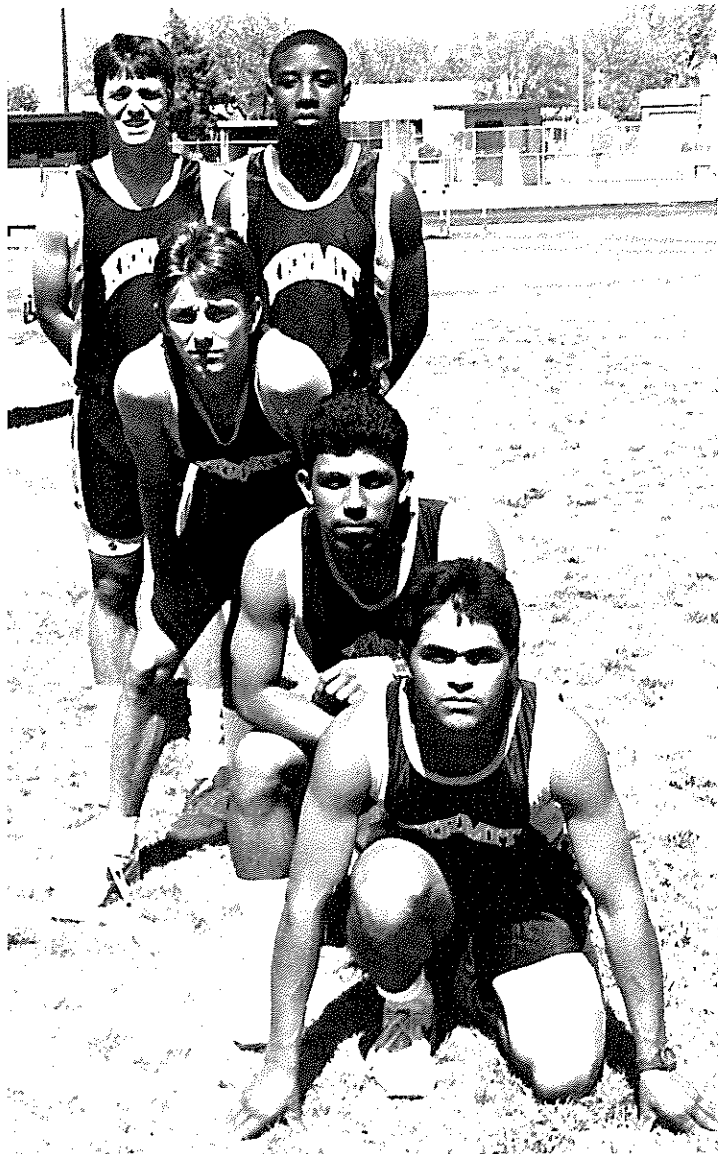
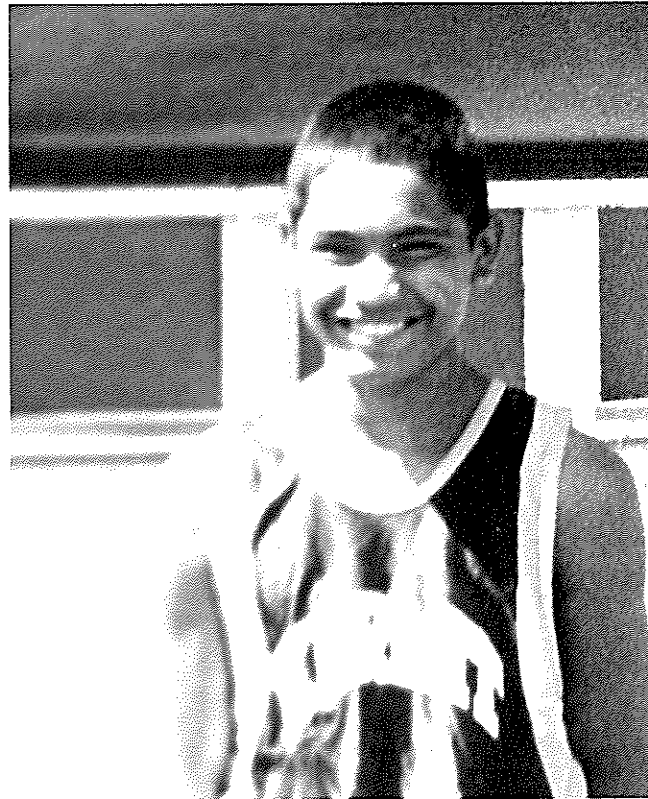
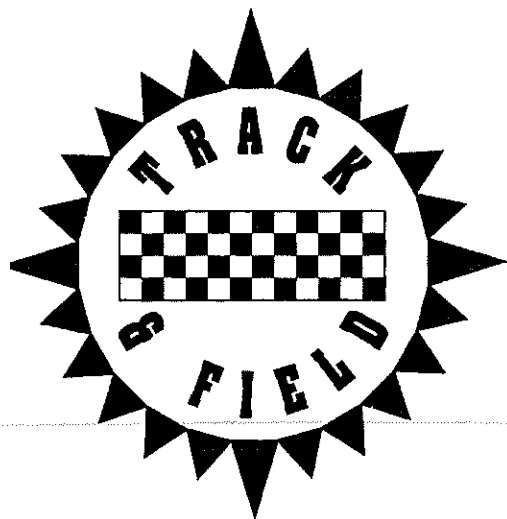


# Track

Qualifying for the regional track are Ramiro Mireles, Arnold Navarro, Cesar Saenz, Bubba Bowerman, Tony Nix, Stanley Birkla, and Edward Draughan.

Track season has come to an end for many. For a select few, however, it has just begun. Friday, April 14, was do-or-die for many thinclads across the state, and the Yellow Jackets were no exception. Kermit qualified runners in three individual events, and took the gold in the 4x100 relay.

Ramiro Mireles advanced to Regionals in the 3200 meter run with a first place time of 11:04, while Cesar Saenz qualified in the 100 and the 200 meter dash. Tony Nix placed second in the shot put with a throw of 47 ft., 6 in. The sprint relay team (Arnold Navarro, Cesar Saenz, Stanley Birkla, Edward Draughn, and alternate Bubba Bowerman) ran their fastest time of the year (44:25) to qualify for regionals with a first place finish.

Also scoring points for Kermit were as follows: Corky McLean - fourth in 800 meter run and sixth in the triple jump, Bubba Bowerman - fourth in 300 intermediate hurdles and fifth in 110 high hurdles, Arnold Navarro - third in 400 meter dash, and Ricky Mireles - fourth in 3200 meter run.

The next step for the Jackets was the regional meet on April 28 at Ratliff Stadium in Odessa.

No Jackets advanced to the state meet in Austin.
