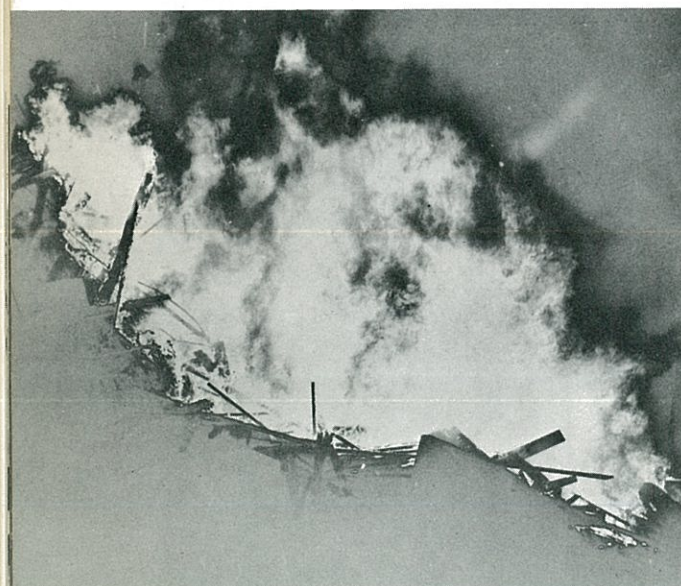


## Bonfire Boosts Jackets' Spirit

*We built the bonfire three times—and finally got to burn it ourselves.*



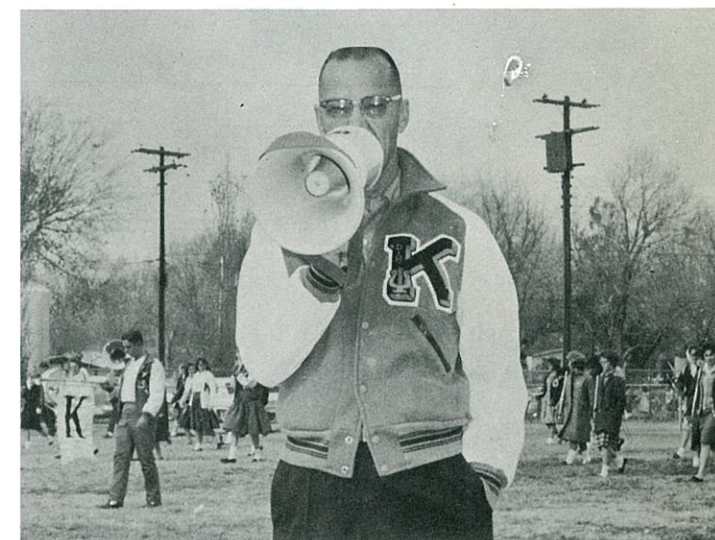

## K Band Goes to Dallas

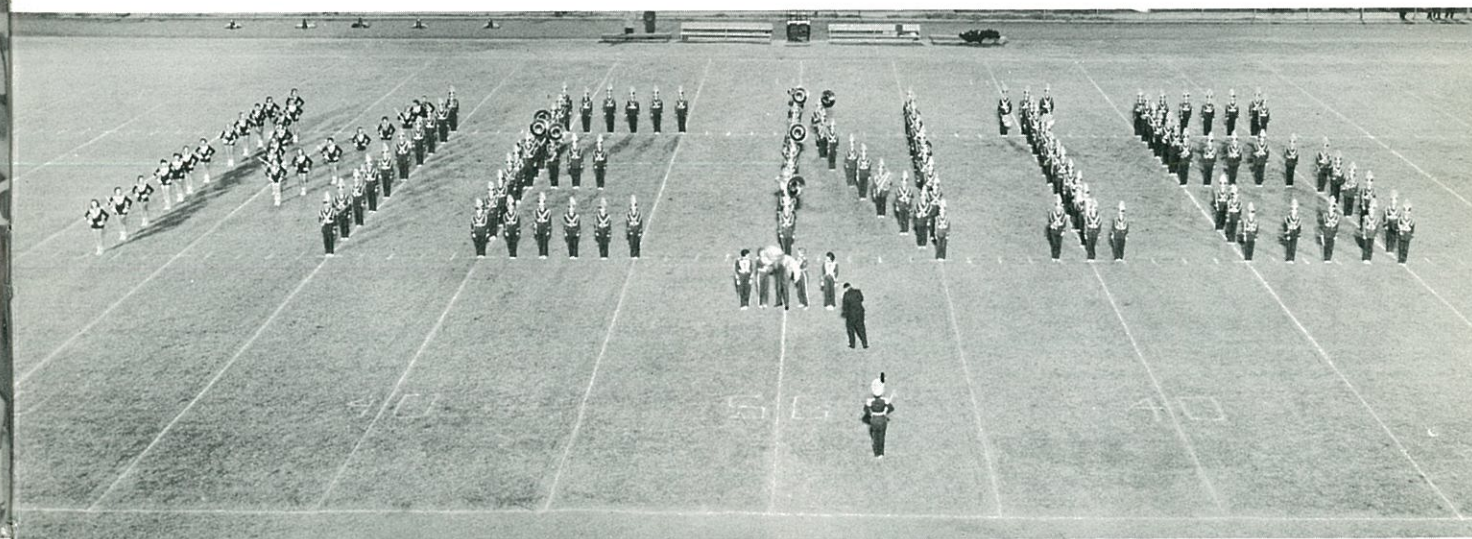
