This has been a banner year for Kermit Schools and a fruitful year for THE SANDSTORM.

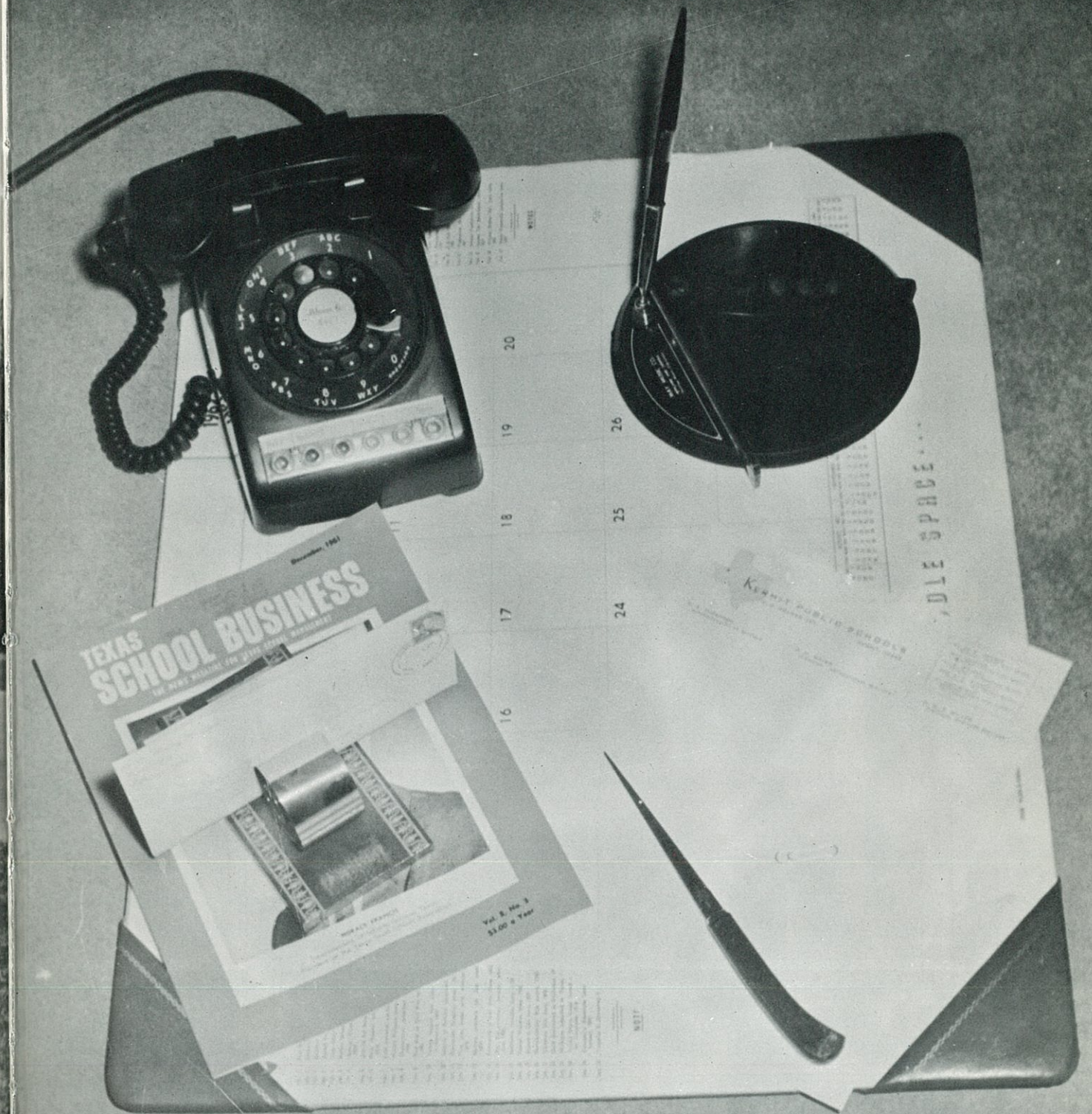
The year began with a record breaking enrollment of over 562 students. Some 218 freshmen mushroomed the population of the halls and classrooms to capacity.
