The teams the Jr. boys played were larger and more experienced, and edged the smaller boys out, but they never gave up, and kept fighting.

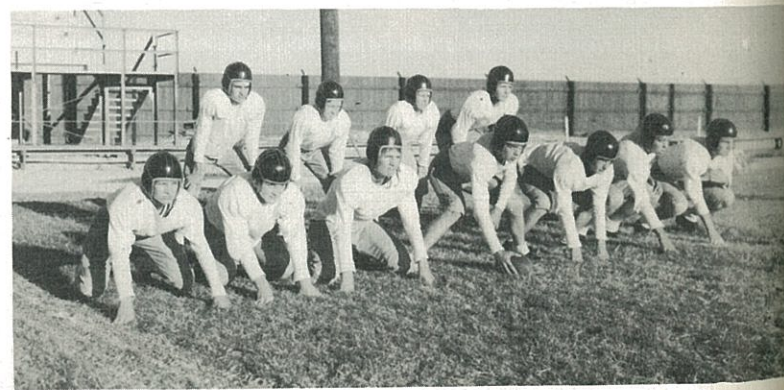
The squad was rewarded at the end of the season by receiving awards of reversible maroon and gold satin jackets.

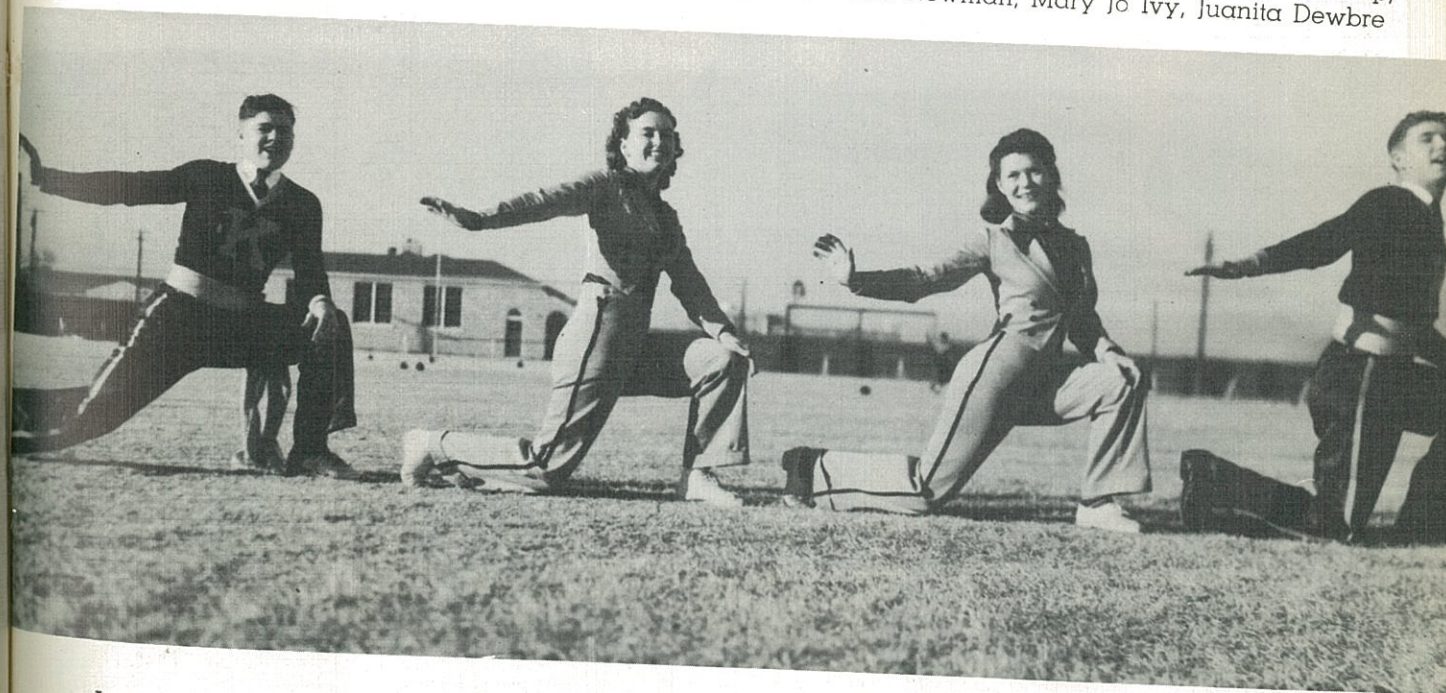
