

The speech class allows students to express vividly their own opinions in good, old-fashioned debates. The art of proper debating and correct speechmaking, and dramatics is taught and illustrated in this class. The speech department entertains the high school with the presentation of short plays during the year.

The Commercial Department offers courses in typing, shorthand, and bookkeeping. These courses enable many students to secure jobs immediately after graduation from high school. Many students, wishing to enter colleges or universities, take advantage of our facilities in preparation for future courses. Others seeking knowledge for individual needs, as well as past graduates, are allowed to enter these courses.



The Spanish Department consists of two years of Spanish. It endeavors to supply the students of Spanish with a competent vocabulary and a basis of Spanish grammar. The students secure a knowledge of Spanish customs, religion, habits and literature.



In their classes in the Social Science Department students learn government and history. From their study of the past these students will learn how to better build the world they are to govern. One day each week is devoted to studying current newsevents.



The aim of the English department is to give the students of KHS a sound foundation of grammar which will enable them to use correct oral and written discourse and to teach an appreciation of all good literature. Literature records the great thoughts and ideals of man, a basis of grammar, and literature is necessary to the advancement of the human mind. Each student is required to study four years of English.
