Dear Students of K. H. S. and K. J. H. S.

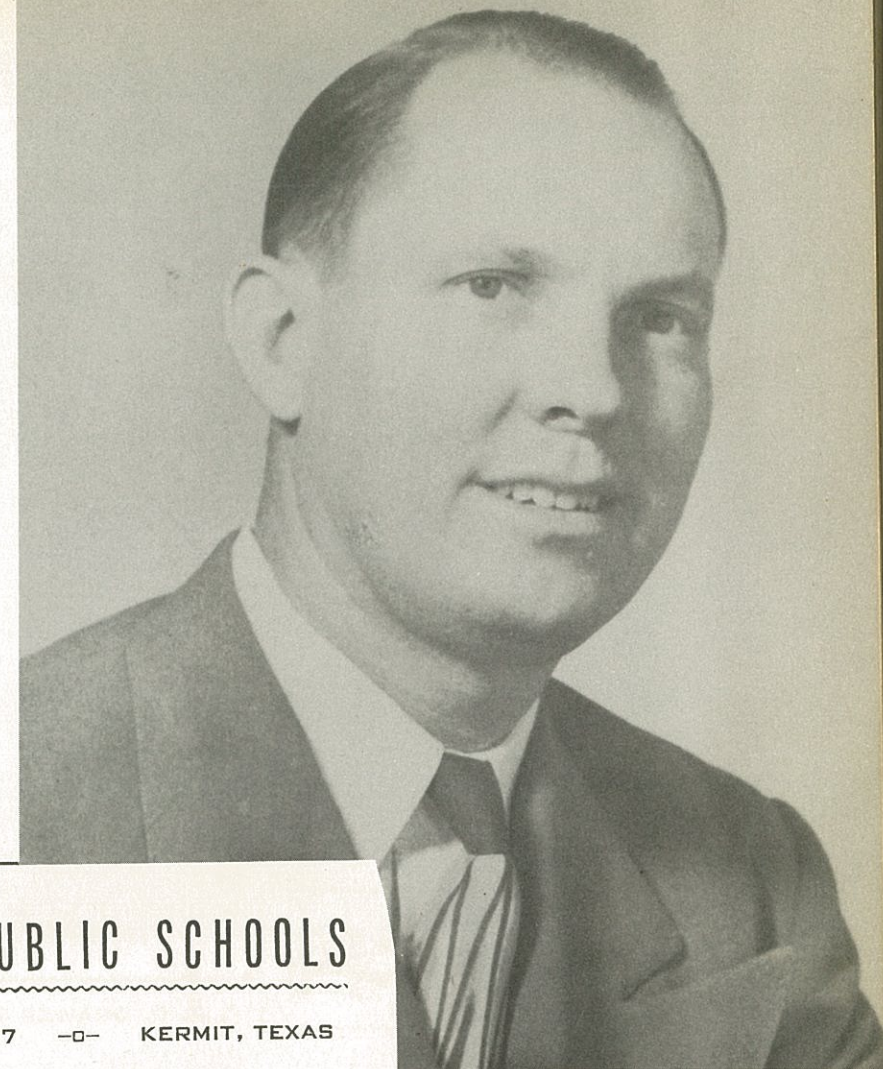
