

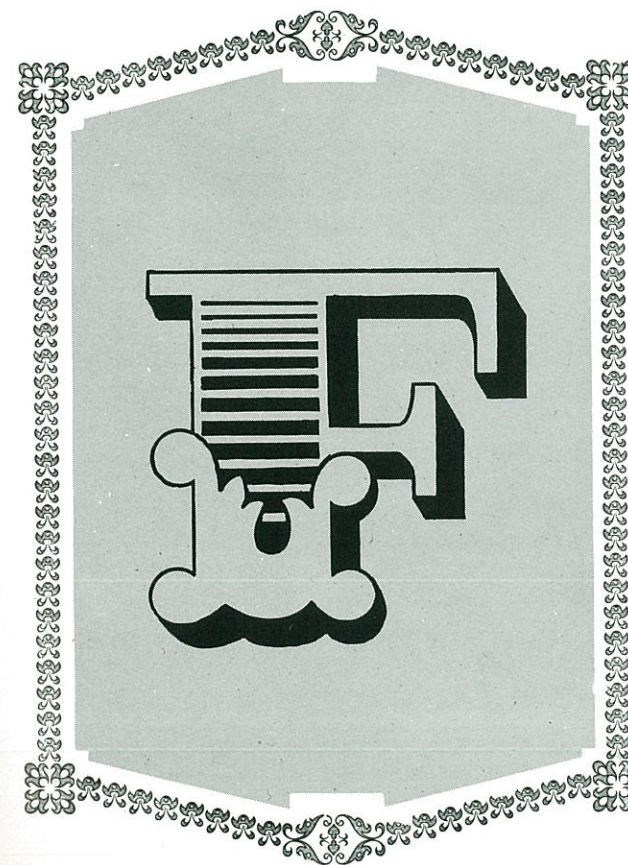
Dedication
