Thespians Stage "Diary of Anne Frank"

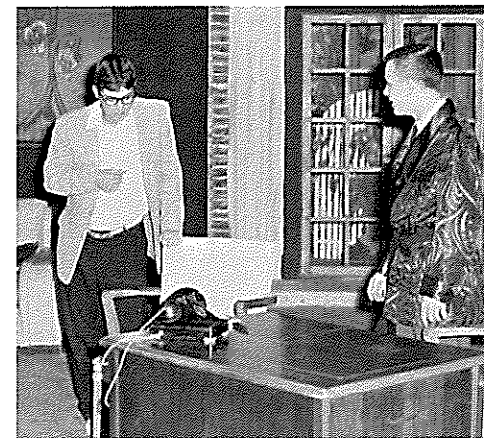
The National Thespian Society, under the direction of Mr. Paul Wilmoth, presented "Diary of Anne Frank" on October 17 in the high school auditorium.

Juniors Present "Who Dun'it?"

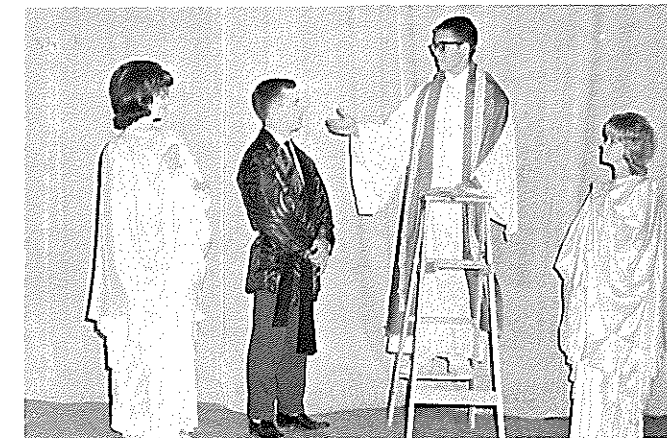
