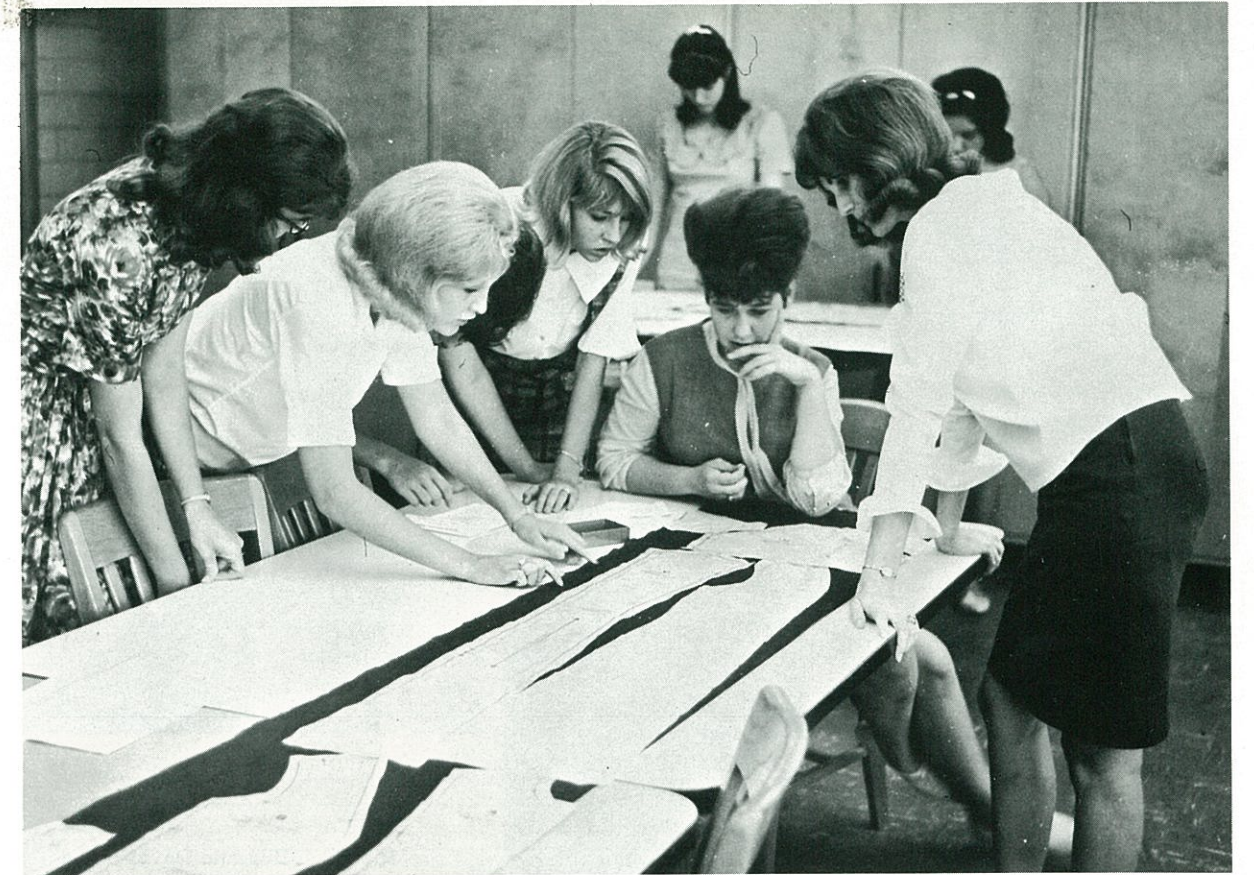




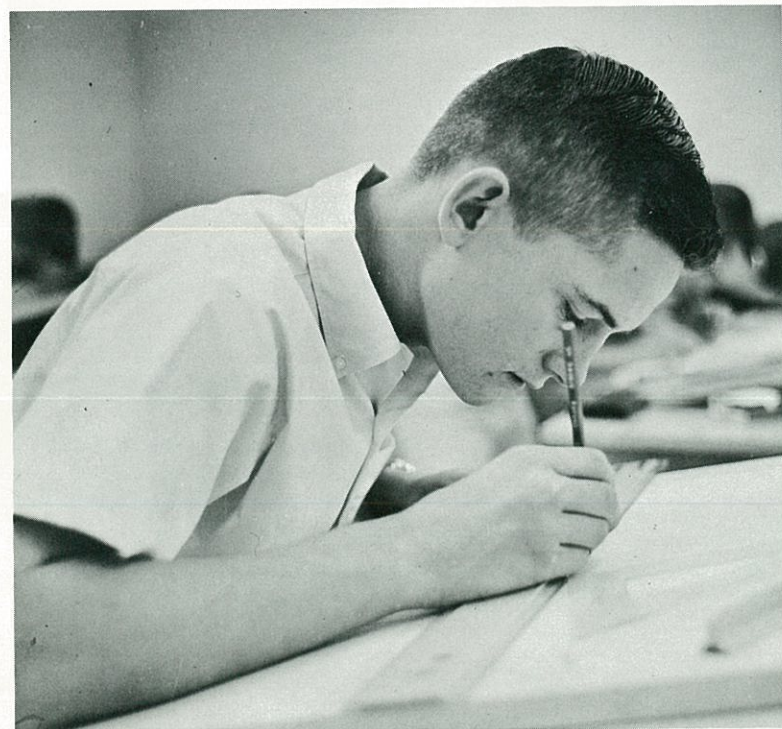
Mrs. Iola Kirby teaches Connie Grantham to purl stitch in home-making.
