Ronnie Burrows, the states best school boy broadjumper, leaped 23'10 1/4" for a new record.

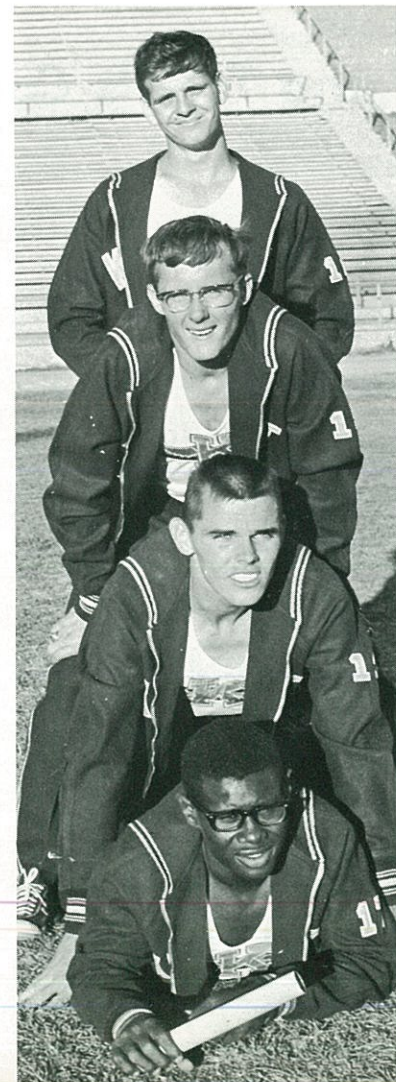
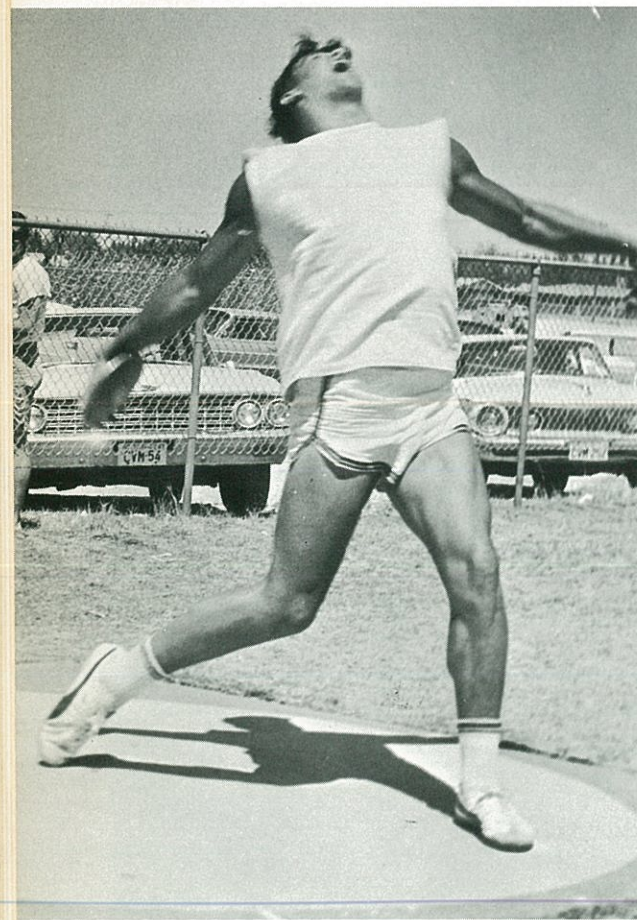
Sophomore Mike Hodges jumped 6'5" to capture second in district and set a new school record.

Donnie Johnson ran 41.2 in 330 intermediate hurdles, a new event this year. John Dampeer hurled the discus 148' 10".

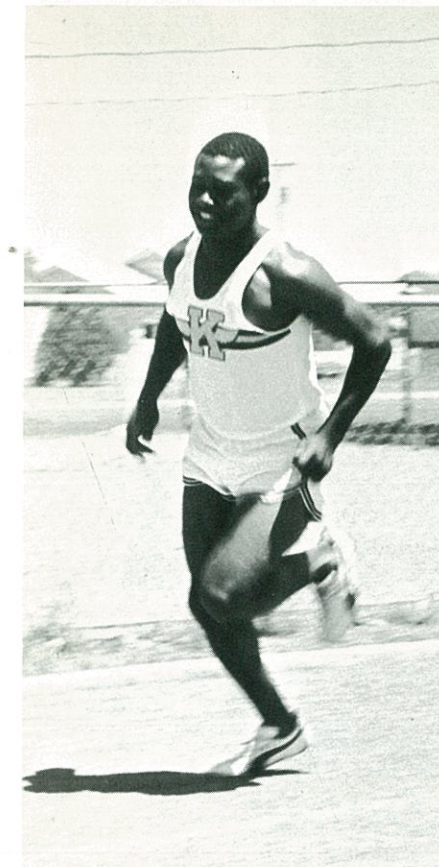
The Sprint Medley Relay team ran 3:36.4 breaking the old mark set in 1963. The team was composed of Eddie Adams (22.8), Burrows (22.7), Johnson (50.5), and Nester Vigil (2:00.4).

Other lettermen were Mac Dampeer who high jumped 5'10". Doug Hestand vaulted 13'6" with Jackie Griffis going 12'. Billy Thompson turned 9.9 in the hundred with Larry Green running 10. Julio Pena placed fourth in the 880 running 2:02.9. Mike McMillan ran a 52.5 quarter in the early season before being injured.
