

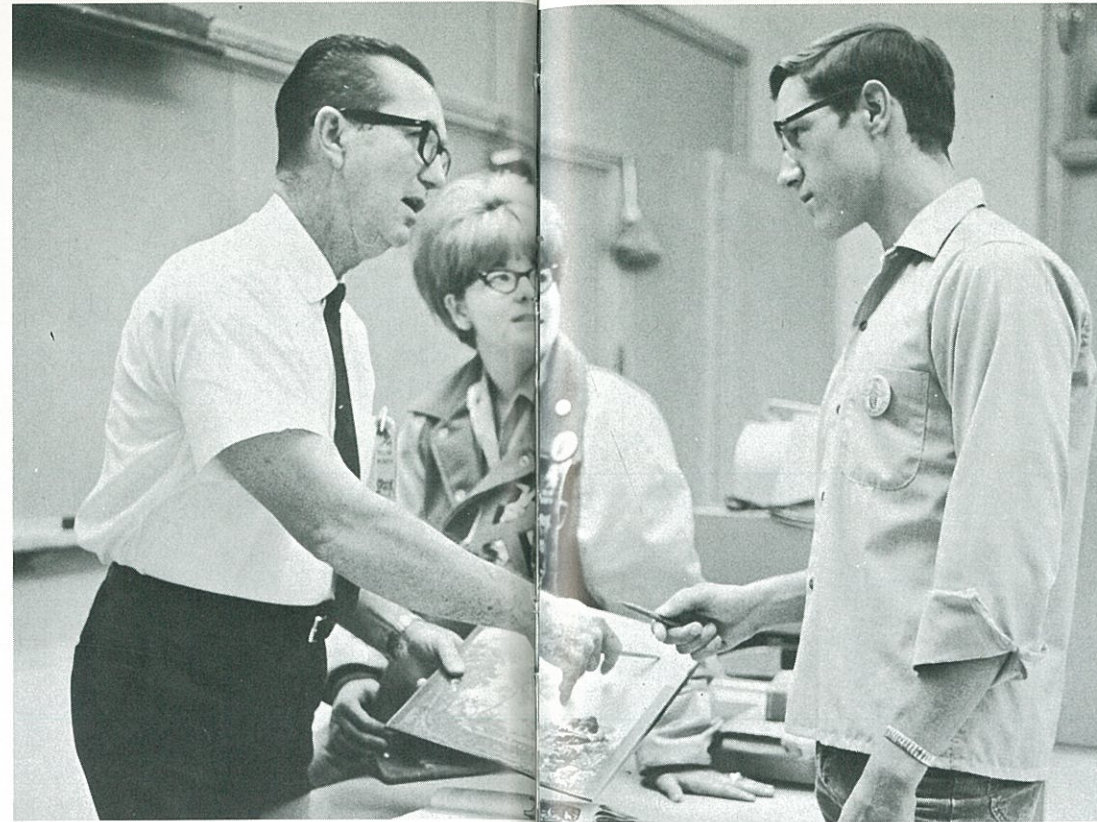
Study of Languages Improves Communication

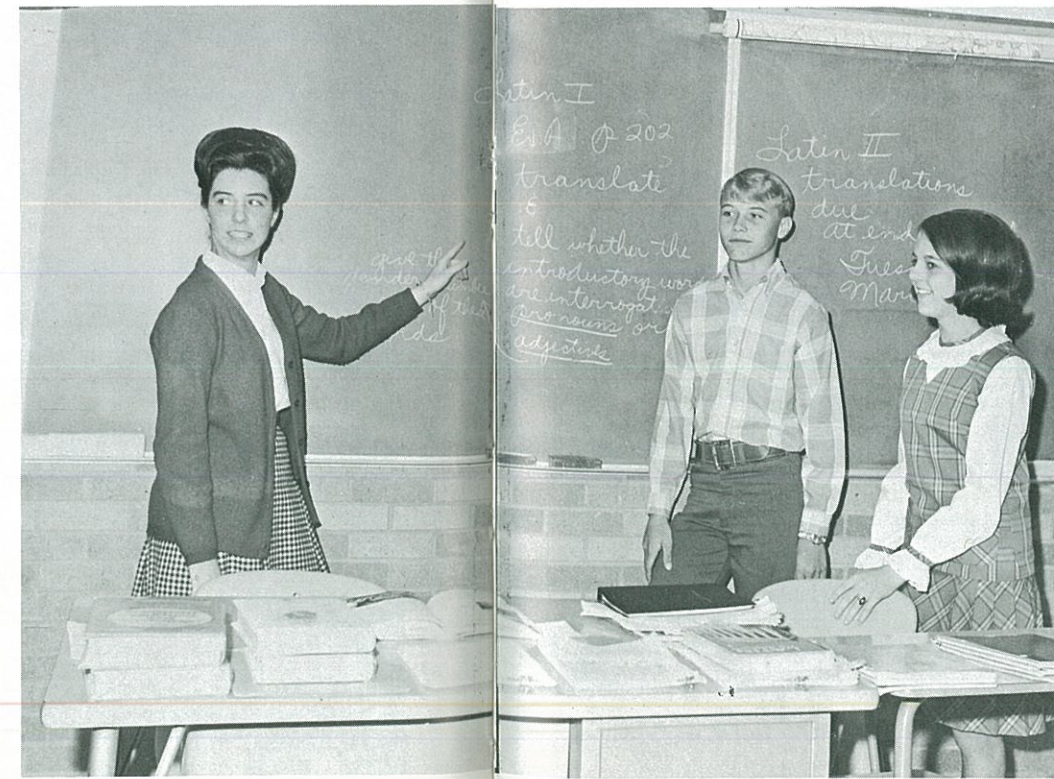
