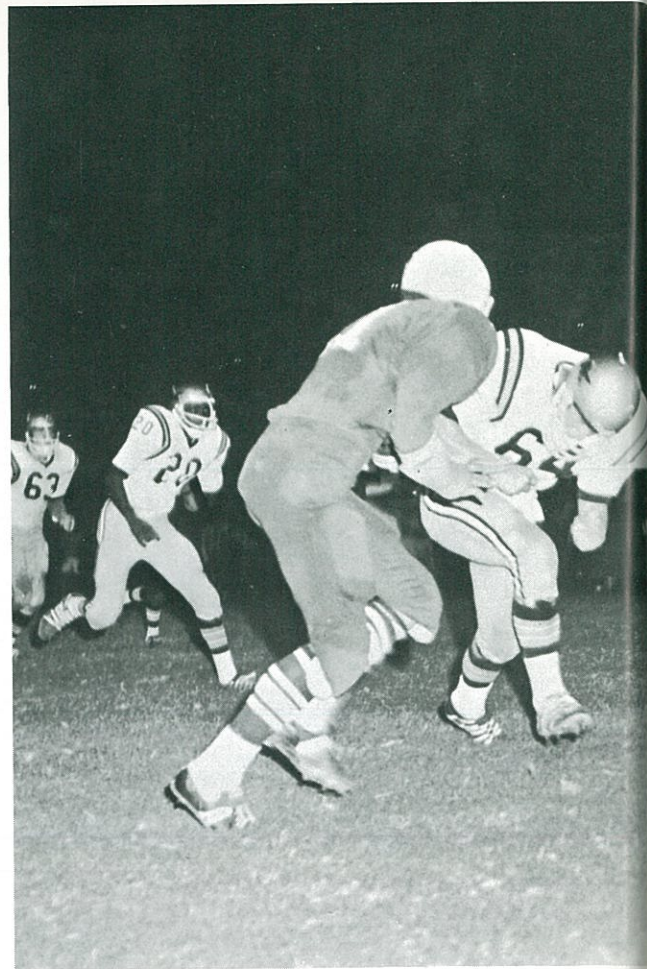

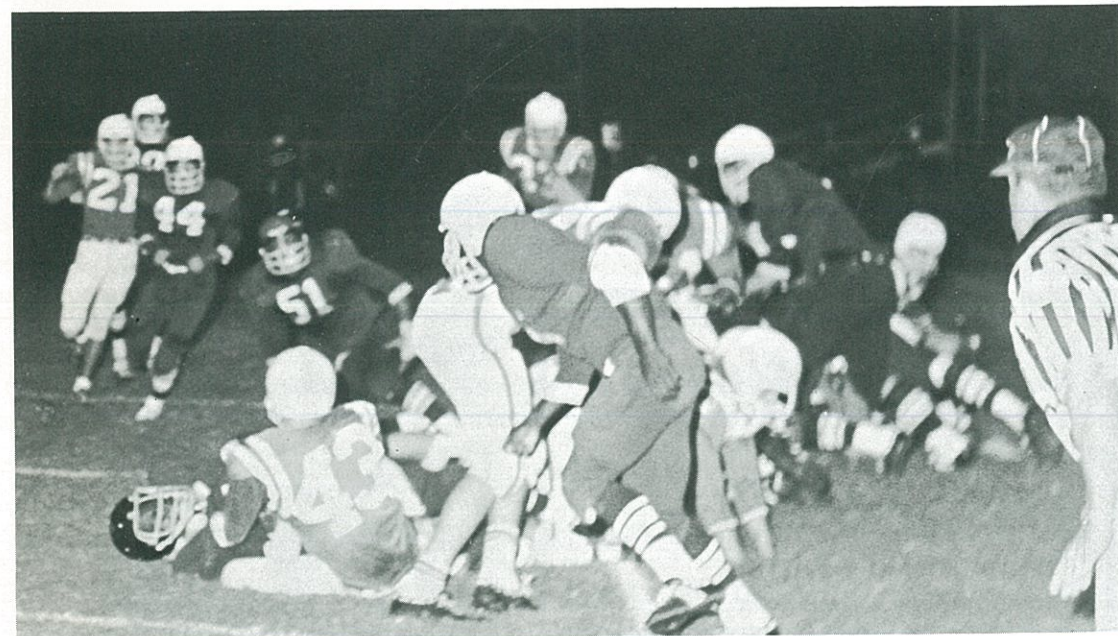
### Kermit 20 - Hobbs 0

The Jackets rolled over the Hobbs Eagles 20-0.

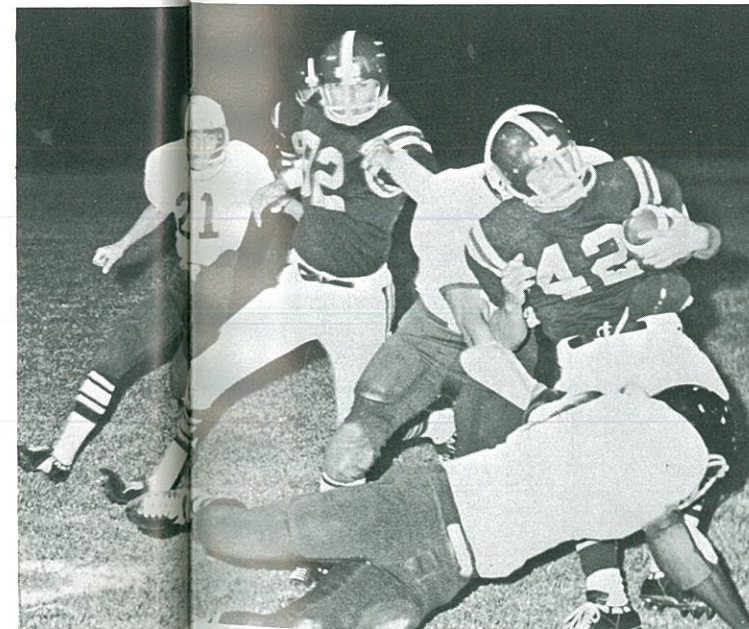
