The Kermit Track Team started the season at the Comanche Relays. The thinclads were unsuccessful in their attempts at first place until the Regional Meet. At that meet the Yellow Jackets became the 1969 Regional Champions. During the year the best times recorded for some of the members were: Mike Hodges ran 39.0 in the 330 hurdles, Frank Sharp jumped 22'6½" in the long jump, Mac Dampeer jumped 6'2" in the high jump and 22'5" in the long jump, Eddie Henderson ran 9.9 in the 100 yard dash and 22.3 in the 220 yard dash, and Neal Munn jumped 20'6" in the long jump.



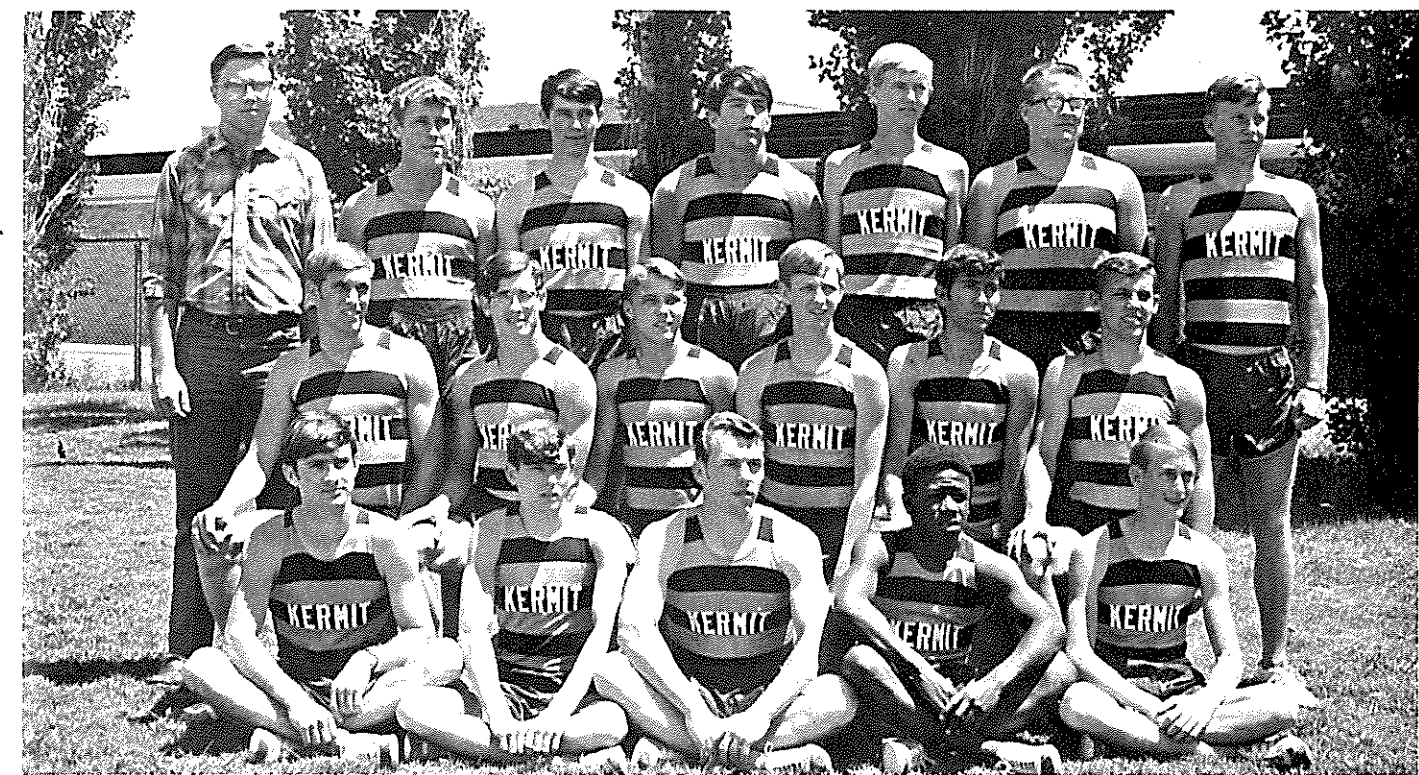
