

The present district of the Kermit School Board has been in operation since 1928. It was established after the first school system was organized. Many various changes have been wrought by this essential organization.

Meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month, unless circumstances prevent their assembly. New Board members are elected the first Saturday in April. State law requires that every school board be composed of no more than seven members. Members are elected according to place number. The School Board President serves for a three-year term, while all other members serve one-year terms.

Policies regarding the Kermit schools must be approved by the School Board before they can be applied to the schools. The Board establishes the dress codes, hair policies, and discusses new equipment to be bought for school use among other important business matters.
