

1974-1975 Yellow Jacket Cagers







This year the Jackets made many accomplishments considering how they were rated prior to the season. Most area coaches picked Kermit to finish last in the district, but they ended up in 4th place. For the season the Jackets were 15-16, but had one first and one Second in Tournament play. Playing teams which were almost always taller-as the Jackets had only two players over six foot-they did an outstanding job. The Jackets averaged 60.7 points a game, their highest game being against Monahans scoring 92 points and also the lowest game against Monahans 28-14. Although much shorter than their opponents the Jackets averaged only one rebound per game less than their opponents. This exemplifies the tremendous effort to overcome many obstacles which faced the '74-'75 Jackets, Coach Todd stated "This is one of the finest teams I have ever coached because of their tremendous pride and determination."
