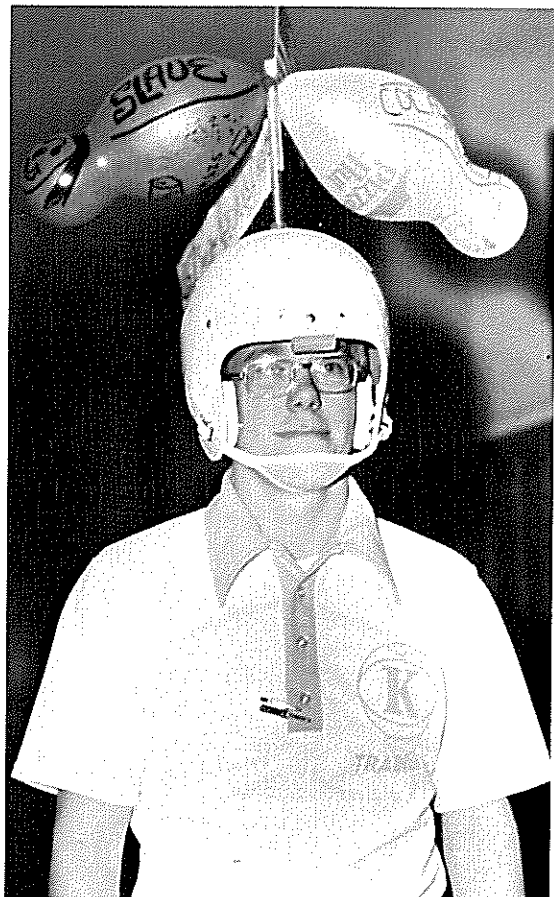


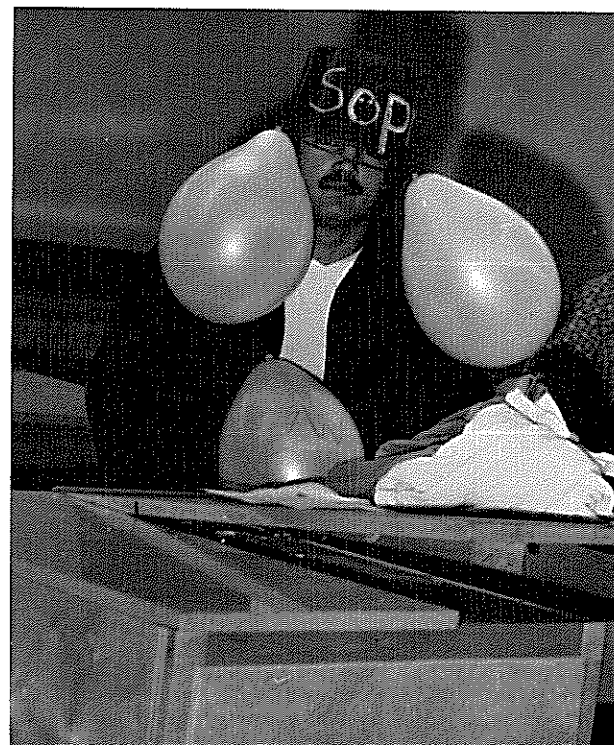

Slaves . . .

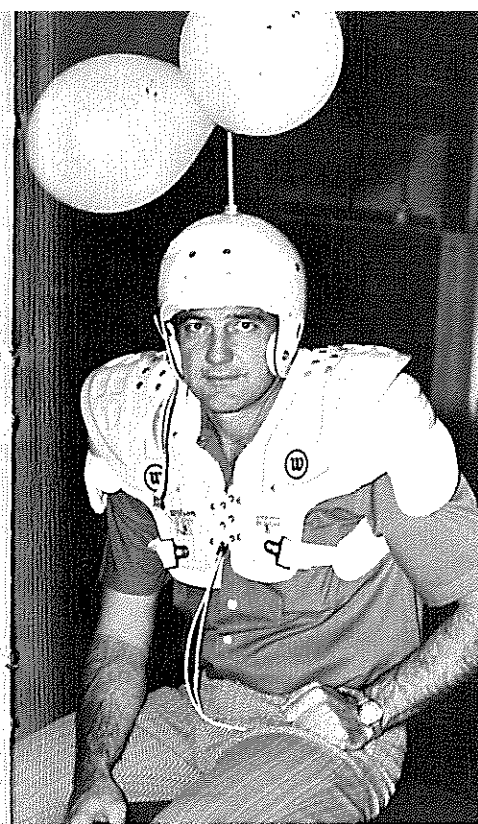
