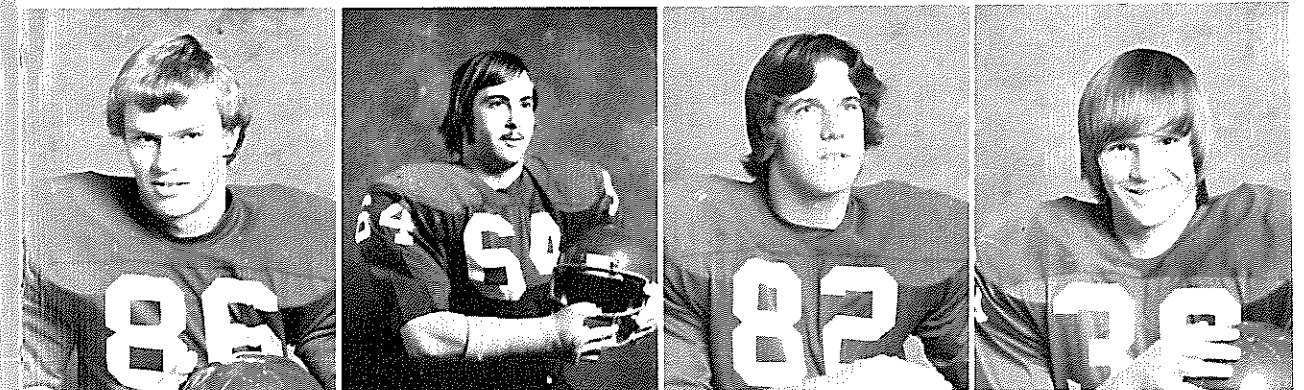


Kimball gets downed by an Indian.

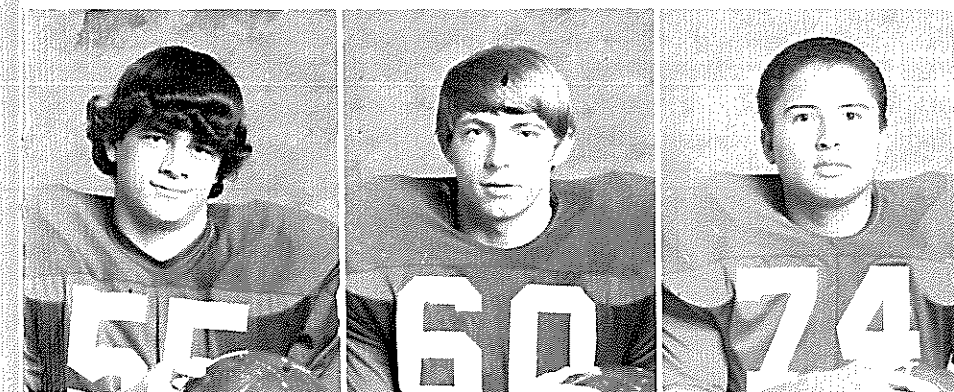
