

# Jackets Take Sonora Broncos 17-14



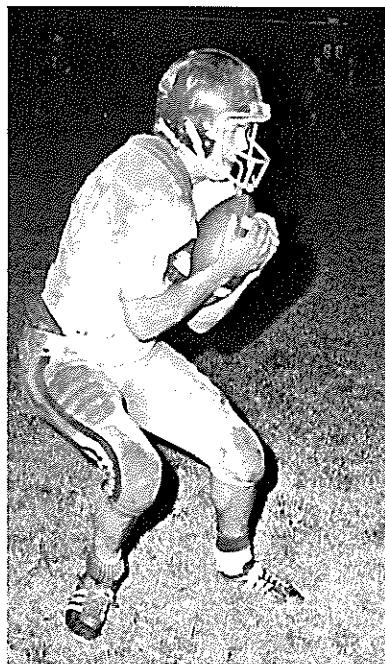
Coaches Strickland, Lackey and Allison design their own pressbox.

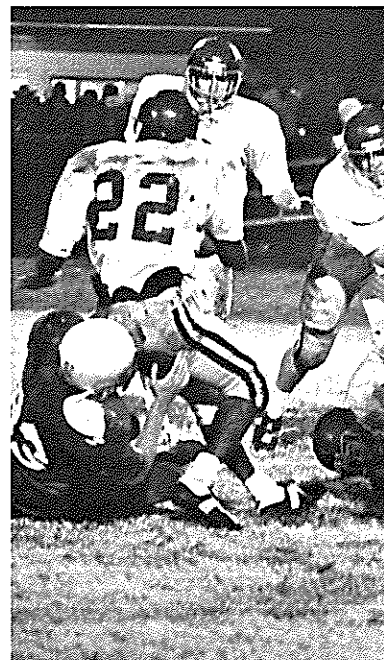
Edwards raced 26 yards for a TD and King added the extra point.

The Broncos then scored, but with 25 seconds left on the clock King kicked a fieldgoal to win the game.



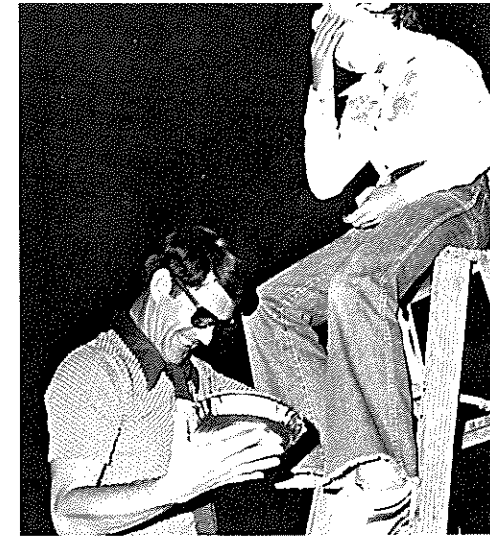
Clifton King kicks the game-winning fieldgoal.



Jackets trample the Broncos.

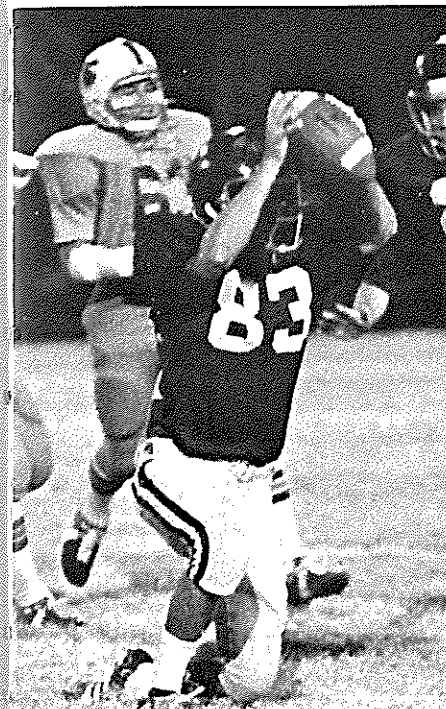

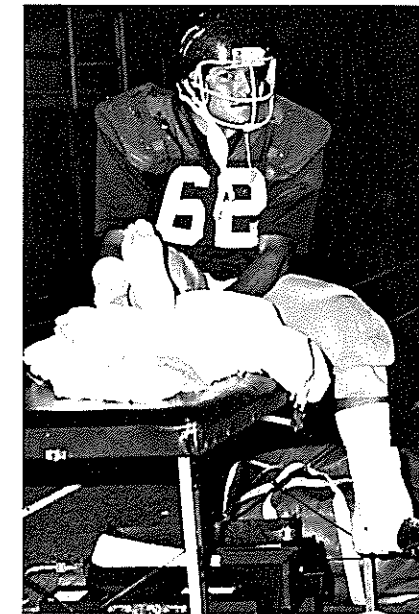

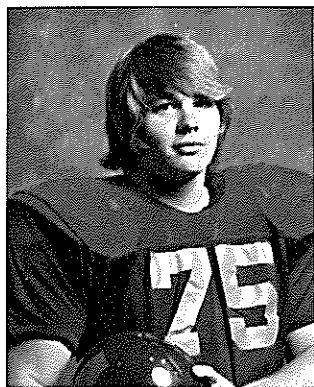

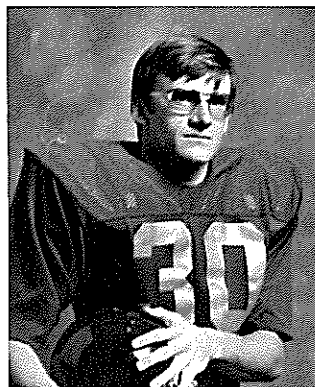

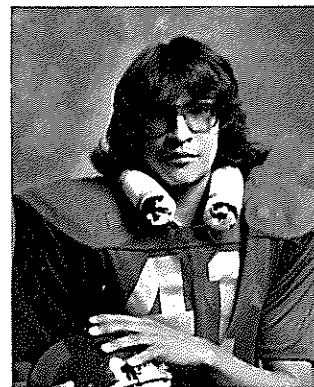
Danny Haygood makes a TD catch.



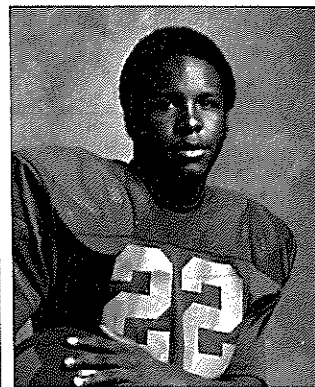

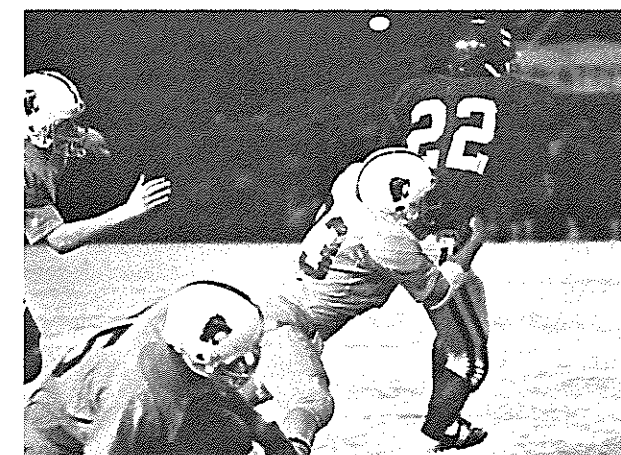
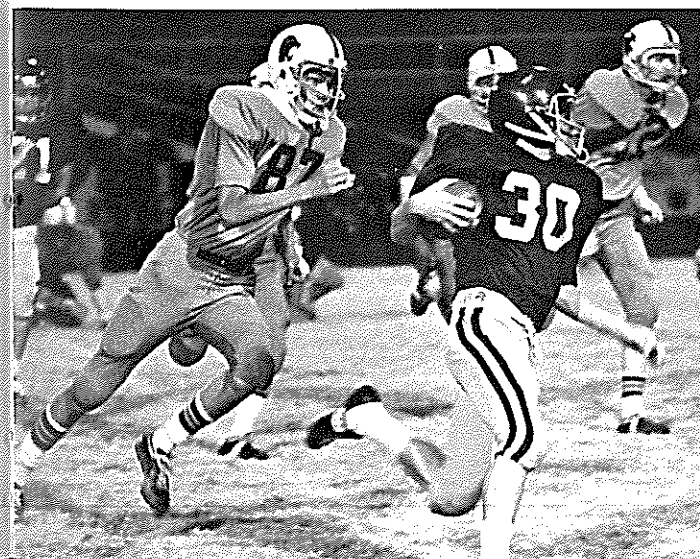
