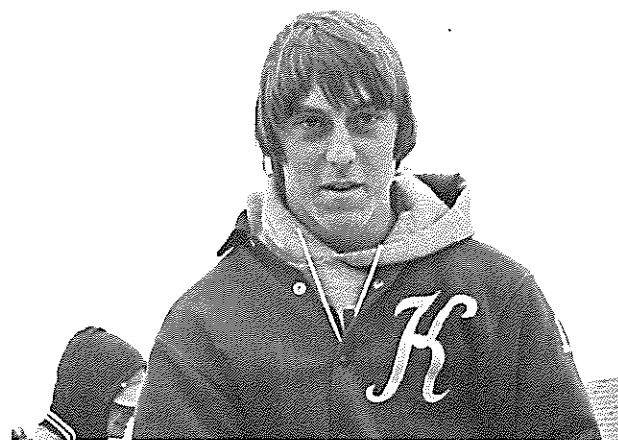


# Jackets Have Successful Track Season



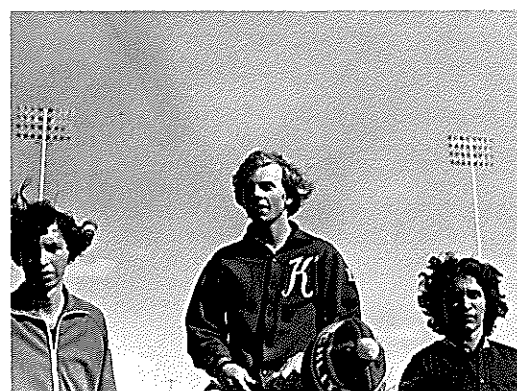
Leslie Baucom receives 3rd place in the Long Jump in the Andrews meet.

Billy Stevens wins 1st place in the Mile Run in Ft. Stockton.



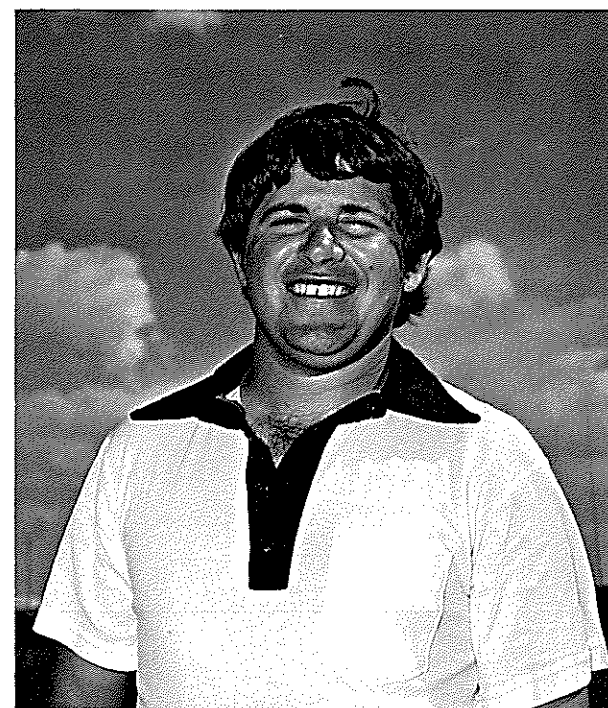
Kent Best strives for the finish line to tally points for the Jackets.

# Junior Varsity Track Team Wins District

The KHS Junior Varsity track team received first place honors at the District 7-AA track meet held in Snora on Friday, April 22. The Kermit thinclads scored 192 points, well ahead of Crane with 76 points for second place. In the Long Jump Kent Shuler placed first with a jump of 18' 7 1/2". Sammy Hancock was third and Mario Marques was fourth. Both relays of Hancock, Marquez, Shuler and Arthur Masiel placed first. In the discus Ed McCasland received first place honors with a toss of 116' 8". Steve Watson placed second and Billy Shepard placed fifth. In the mile run James Boring won with a time of 5:22 and Latral Hanna was second. Shepard placed second in the 880 and Benny Carrasco was sixth. Shuler placed second in the shot put with McCasland placing sixth. In the 100 Darrell Holt was second and Malcolm Bryant was fifth. Masiel was first in the 440 with a time of 54.7. Hancock was second and Holt was fifth. In the 330 hurdles David Watson was first and Billy Shepard was second.
