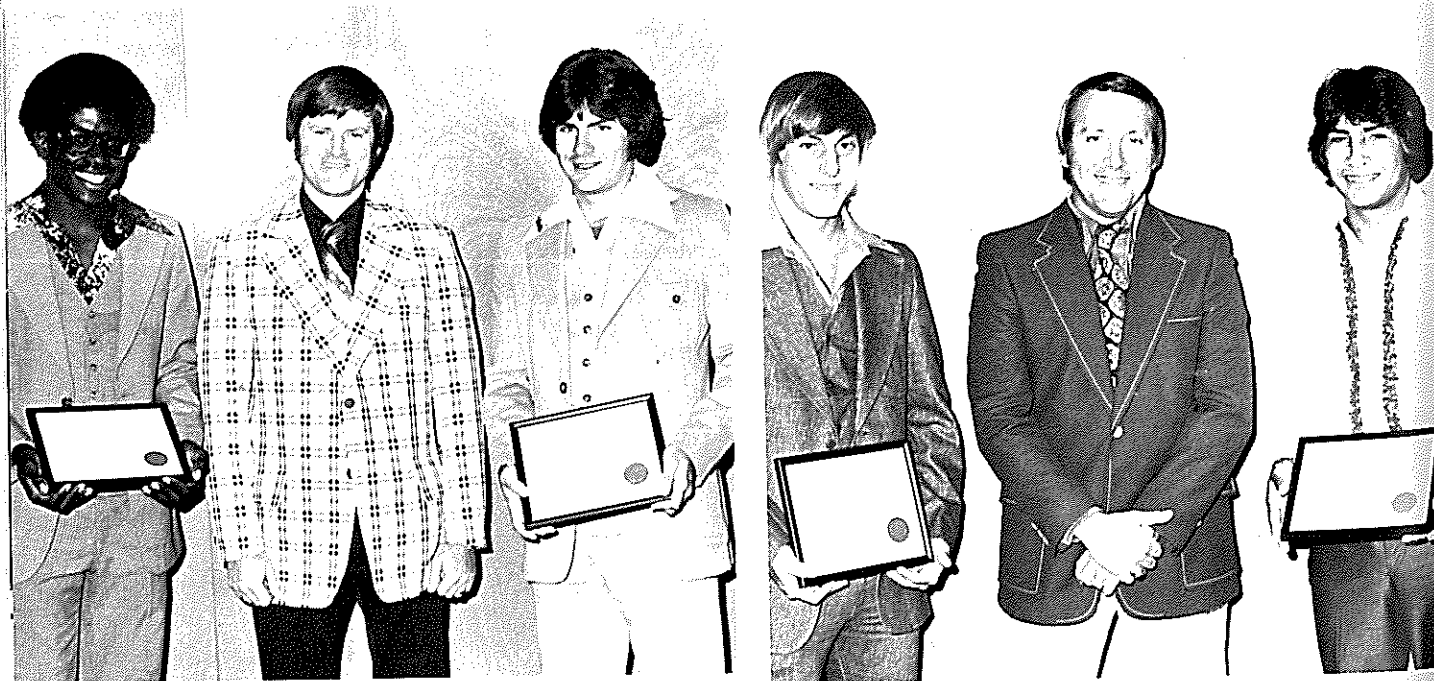
The Most Valuable Player Awards for 1977-78 in girls' track were received by Patty Richardson (left) and Amber McCasland.
