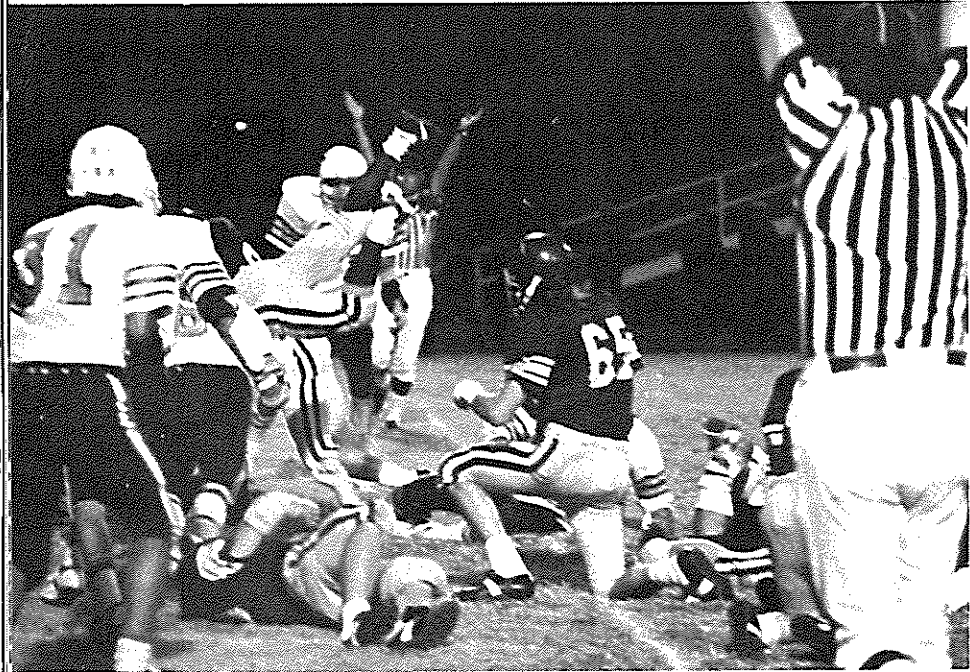


# Jackets Tame The Wildcats 34-6

# Jackets Sneak By Sonora 7-3

The Sonora Broncos fell to the Yellow Jackets in a close 7-3 grid clash as the KHS squad opened district 7-AA play.

The game was definitely a defensive battle as Kermit managed one touchdown in the final quarter, while Sonora simply scored one fieldgoal just before the half.

The Broncos were able to capitalize on only one of four KHS turnovers in the first half of play when they kicked a 25-yard fieldgoal after a Kermit fumble.

Trailing by three points going into the final quarter, Jacket QB Scott Edwards found end Junior Velasquez on a 21-yard pass combination which resulted in the winning touchdown.

The TD came at the end of a 67-yard drive that started late in the fourth period on the KHS 33-yard line. Les Baucom added the PAT.

The 1977 KHS Homecoming Game was a definite success as the Jackets downed the Fabens Wildcats 34 to 6. This was the fifth and final non-district victory of the season for the Jackets.

Jacket scoring activity began early as Junior Velasquez snagged a 44-yard TD pass from QB Scott Edwards. Les Baucom added the PAT.

Linebacker Montie Wren picked off a Fabens pass and set up the second KHS tally. Alfred McGilbra crossed the goal for the TD. Again Baucom added the PAT.

Ray Jennings scored the third TD to give the Jackets a 20 point halftime lead.

In the third period both Velasquez and McGilbra scored TD's and both PAT's were good.

The Wildcats managed to score their only TD of the night after a spectacular 72-yard punt by Brent Barrs.

# Jackets Slip Past The Lions 14-13

As the Jackets marched toward their 1977 District title, they defeated the Ozona Lions 14 to 13.

The Jackets drew first blood on a 15-yard run by Alfred McGilbra. The score capped a 56-yard drive which began on the KHS 34. Les Baucom booted the PAT to give the KHS squad a 7 point advantage.

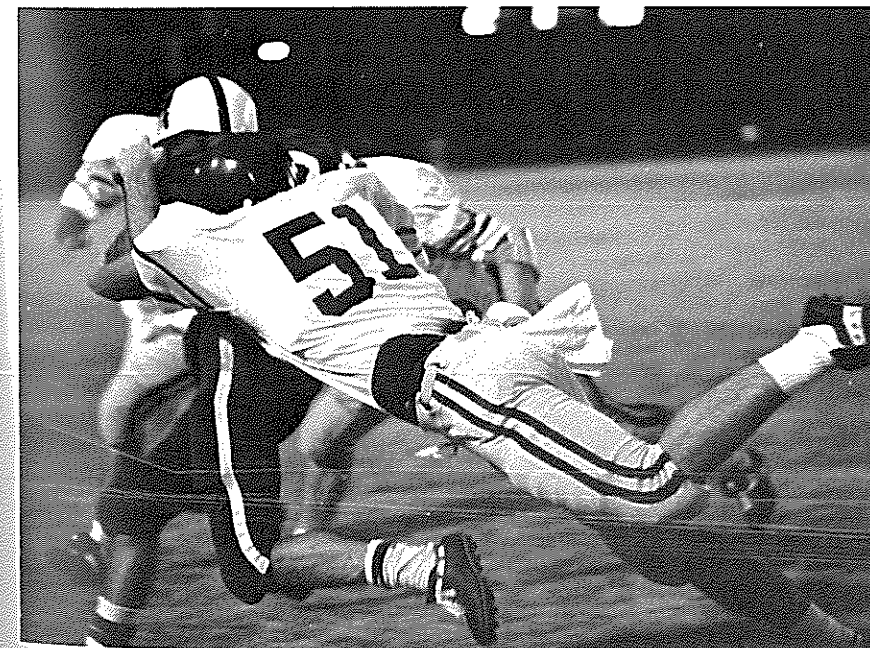
