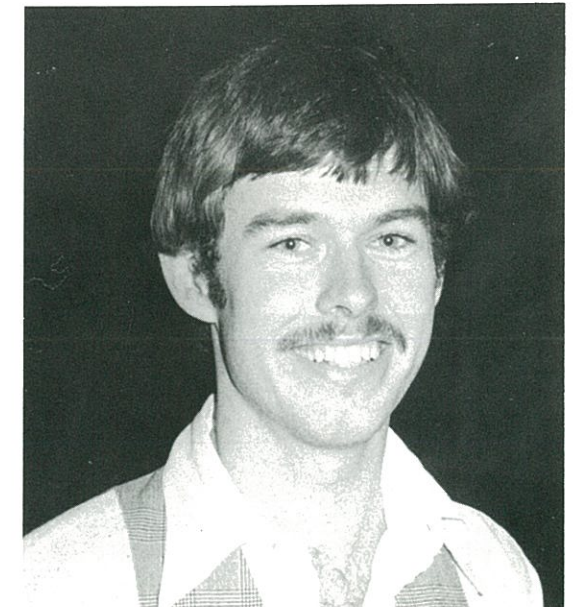
A hilariously funny play "Tom Paine" was presented during the 1979 school term by members of the KHS Junior Class.
