Jackets Begin Season With Wins



Leading the Jacket offense were Alfred McGilbra and quarterback Brent Barrs.


In the second game of the season the Jackets zipped by a surprisingly tough Denver City squad by a 14-0 margin at Walton Field.




Mike Speed (44) displays his running ability against the Alpine Bucks. Looking for a block is Edwin McCasland (55).




Todd Ethridge (20) squirts through a hole in the line as Roland Bell (72) blocks for him. Final score: Kermit 14 — Denver City 0.




David Fulbright (11) cludes the grasp of a Monahans Lobo as the lackets battled Monahans to a 17-17 tie.
