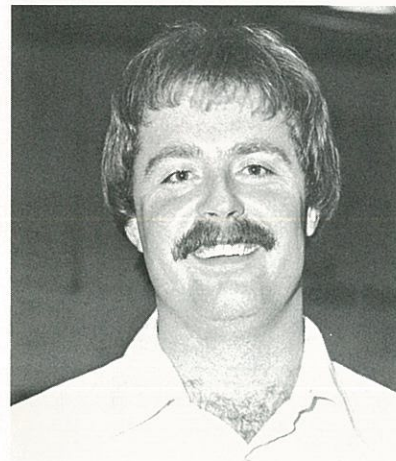


# Eighth Cagers Have Good Season
