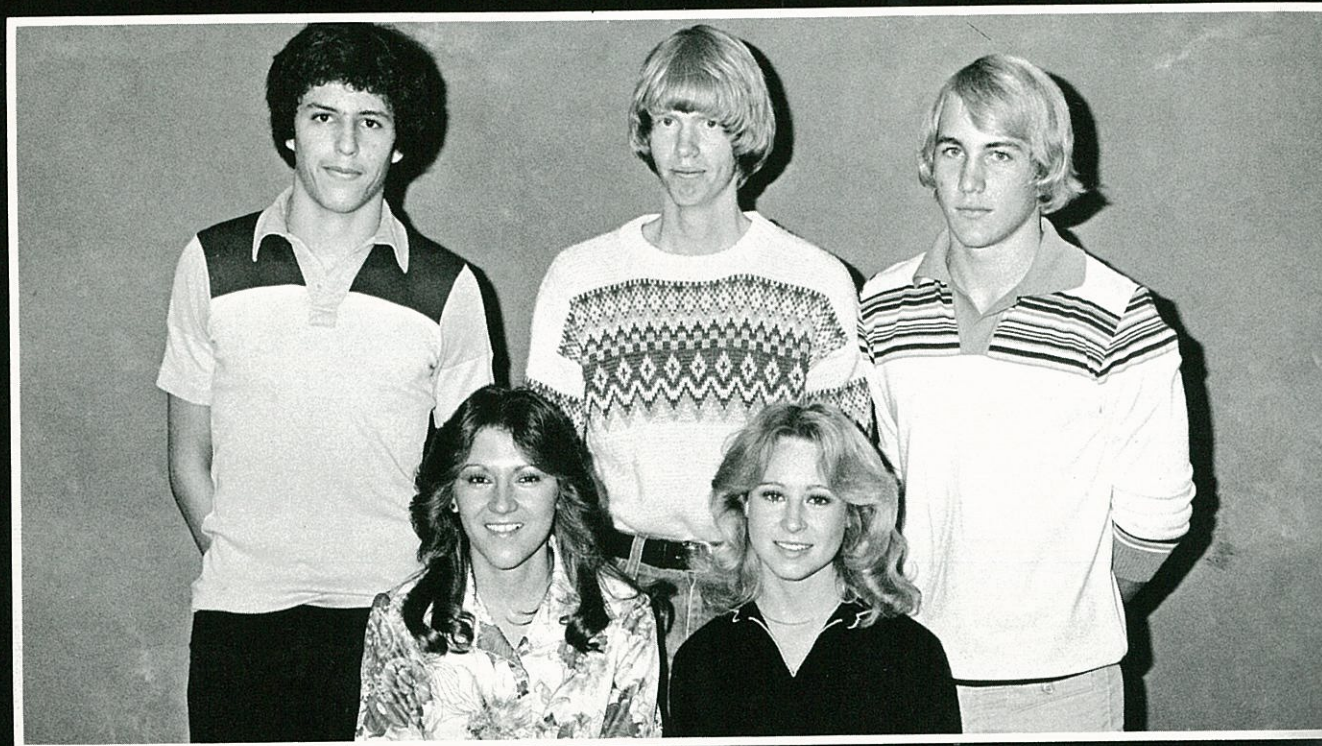


1978-79 Senior Class Officers

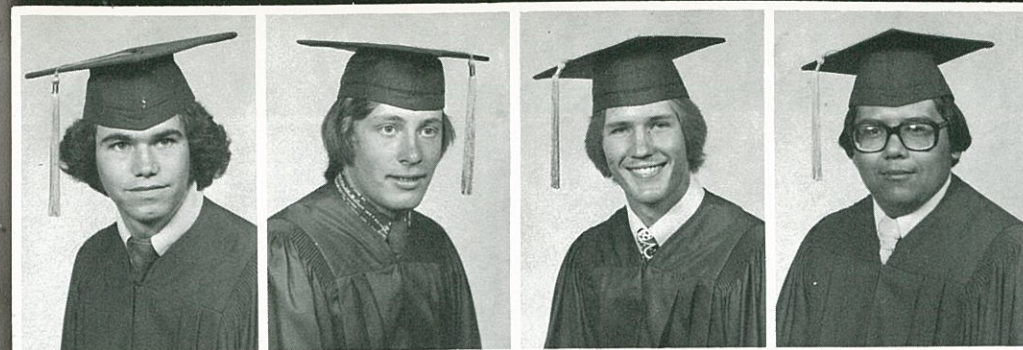

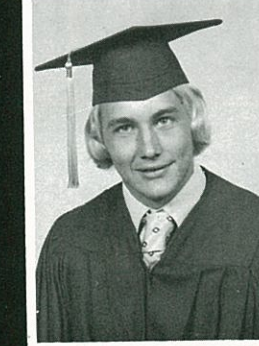
