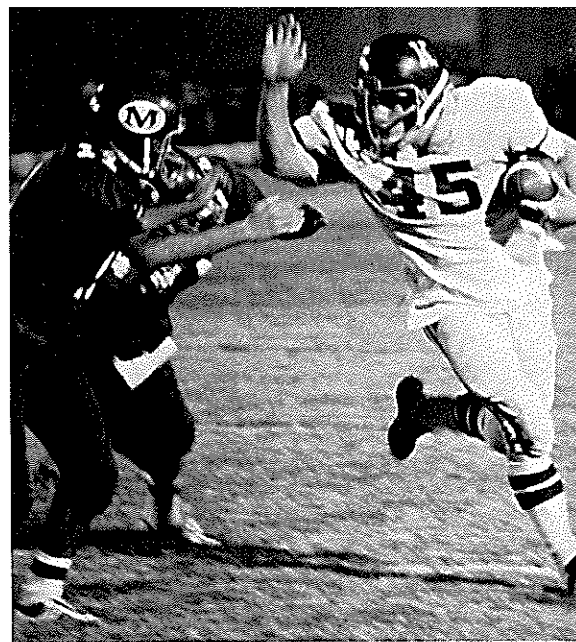


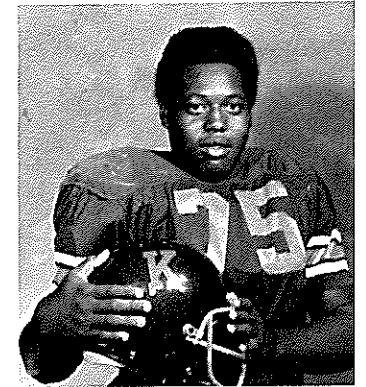
John Kurtz signals touchdown as quarterback David Fulbright scores the lone Jacket TD.



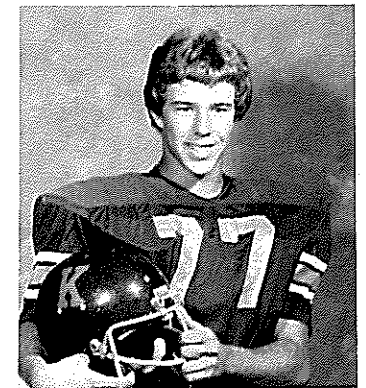
Shannon Cooke evades Lobo tacklers.



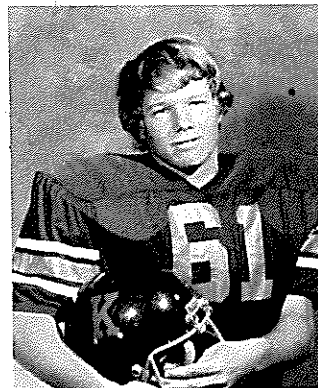
Yellow Jacket tailback Lino Lujan crashes head to head in the always tough Kermit-Andrews clash.



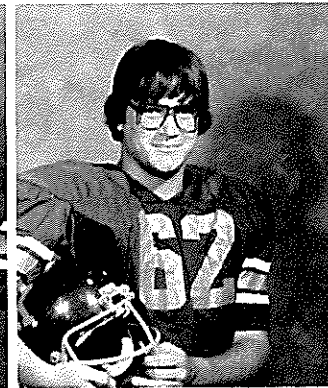

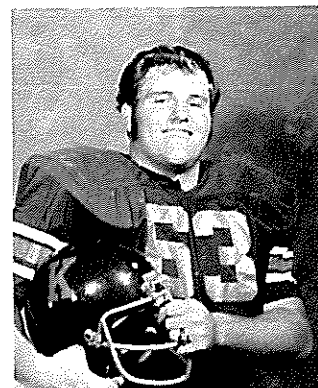

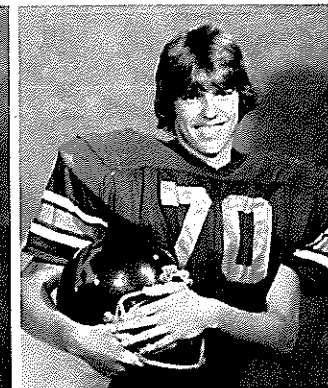
Kermit nearly doubled Monahans in total yardage, but six turnovers cost the Jackets the game.

David Fulbright ran nine yards for a touchdown. Layne Nutt added the PAT.

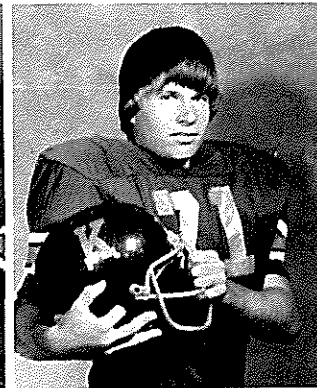

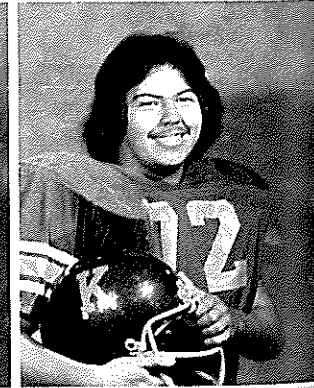

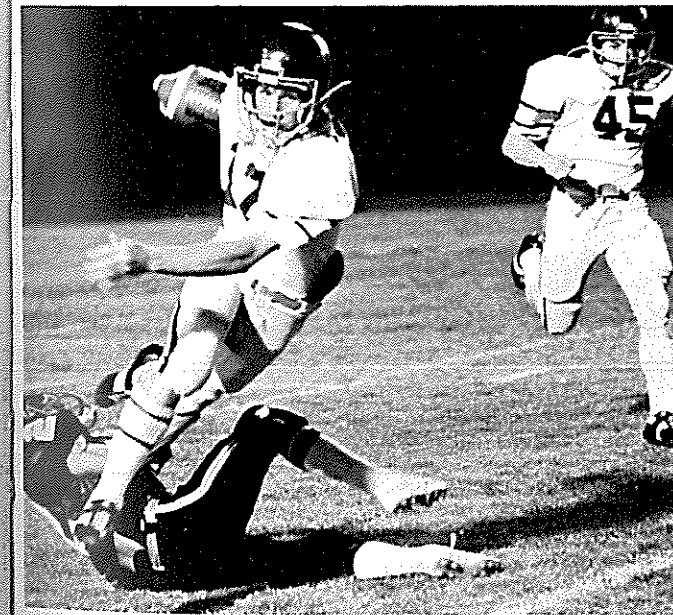

The Kermit Yellow Jackets invaded Mustang territory for their sixth contest of the season. Andrews, in their homecoming, defeated the Kermit bunch in a hard-hitting battle 14-0. The game was a great defensive struggle with many bruising tackles displayed. Turnovers and an outstanding kicking night by the Andrews punter continually kept the Jacket offense bottled up. The Yellow Jackets once again won the statistics but lost on the scoreboard where it counts. The loss was the second in a row to the bigger 2-AAA representatives.
