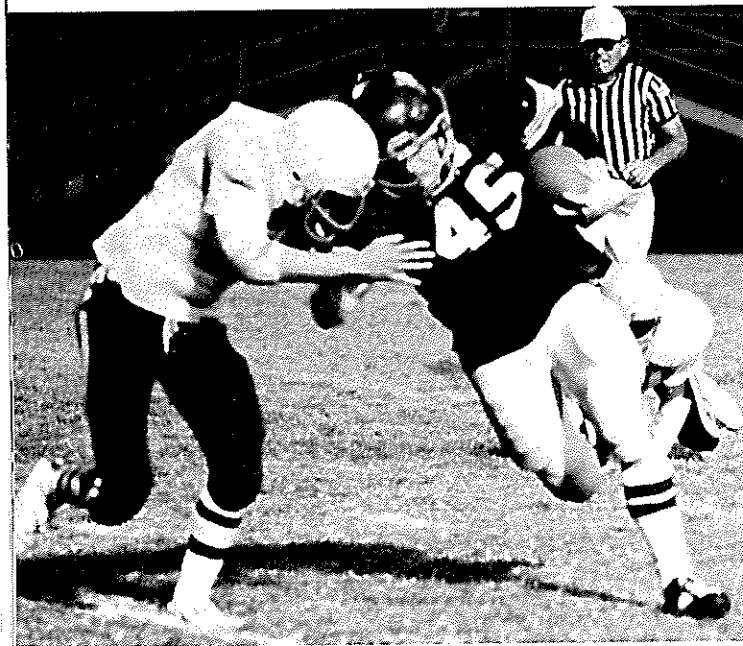
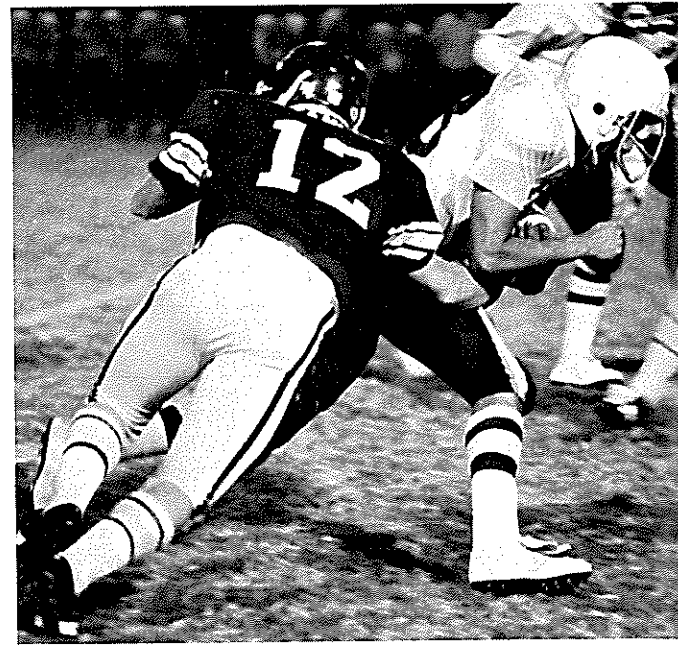


'Cats' Win Homecoming Grid Clash

Cornerback Earl Stanley comes up and holds Fabens to a short gainer on this play.

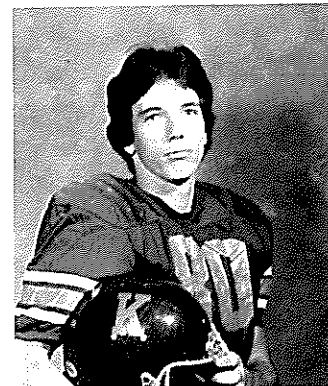


Teke Norwood, Miss Taylor's escort, crowns her as the 1979 Homecoming Queen.

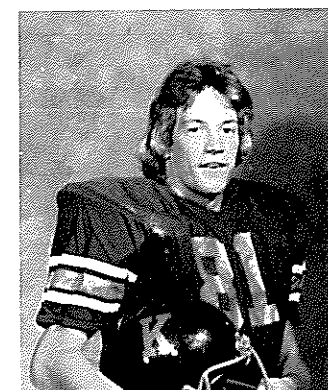

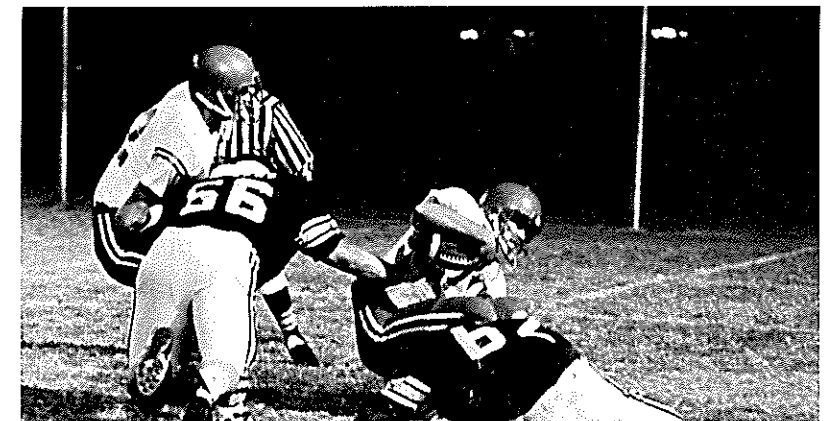

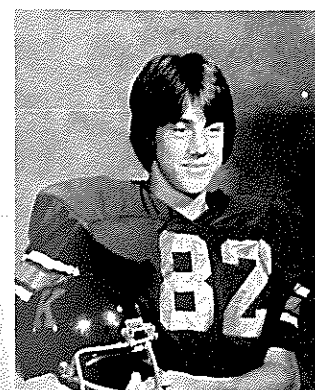
Jacket defensive lineman Terry Folmar brings a Sonora ball carrier to a screeching halt.



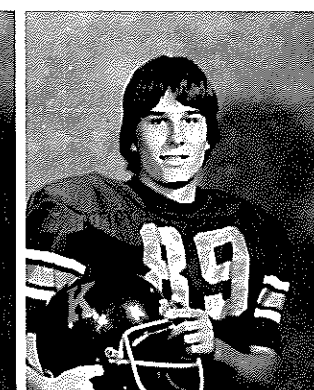
QB David Fulbright discusses strategy with head coach Earl Overton.



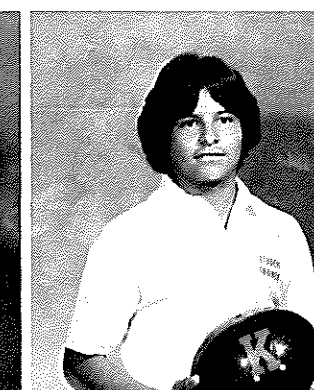
Defensive lineman David Watson and noseguard Clay Stevens (66) give Sonora some minus yardage.



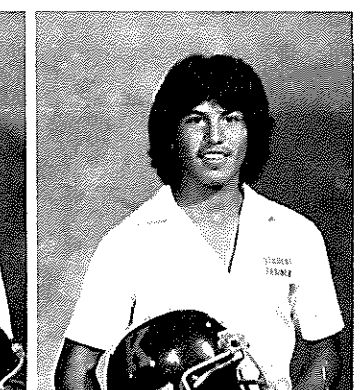
