

Ozona Lions Fall 35-0

With the help of two big first-half plays and a fourth-quarter offensive explosion, the Kermit Yellow Jackets routed the Lions of Ozona in Ozona by a score of 35-0.

To get the Jackets rolling, Roland Bell recovered an Ozona fumble in the end zone. As the ball bounced on, quarterback Earl Stanley found tailback Lino Lujan on a swing pass for a 49 yard touchdown play. The fourth quarter went much the same way with the Jackets playing tough defense to keep Ozona out of the endzone.

Jackets Blast Golden Cranes 26-7

Once again the Jackets played an outstanding defensive game as they held Crane to just 7 fourth quarter points. Also, the Jackets scored 12 of their 26 points in the opening minutes of the game. The whipping of the Golden Cranes gave the Kermit squad a 3-0 record and their third district title in as many years.

The Jackets only gained one more first down than did the Cranes, but the Jackets controlled the ball on the ground with 45 rushes for 256 yards, while the Cranes gained 102 yards on 29 rushes.

Yellow Jackets Go To Bi-District

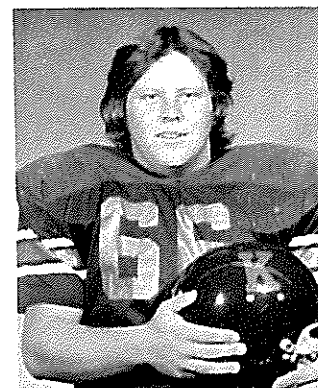
The district champion Yellow Jackets tangled with the fired up Wildcats from Fabens in Bi-District action only to lose by a 21-0 margin.

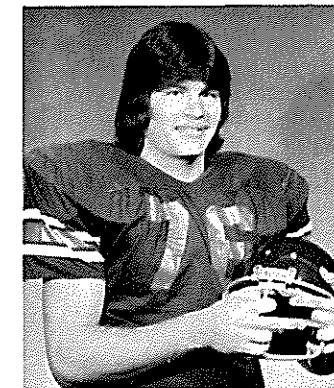

Malcolm Bryant jaunts through a large hole opened up by strong tackle Roland Bell.

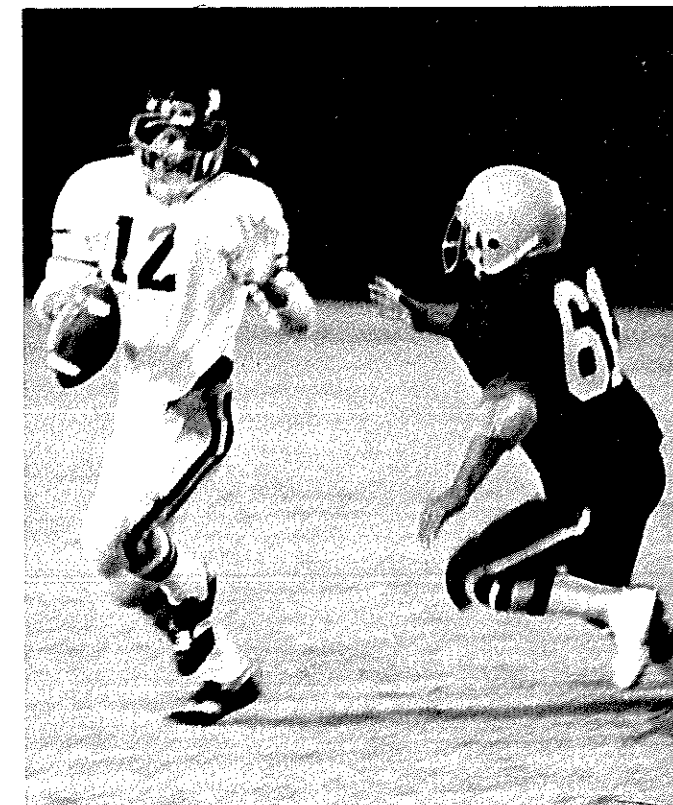
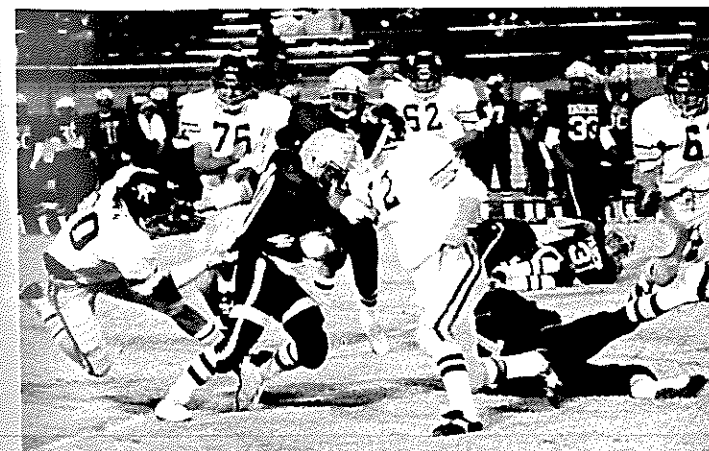
