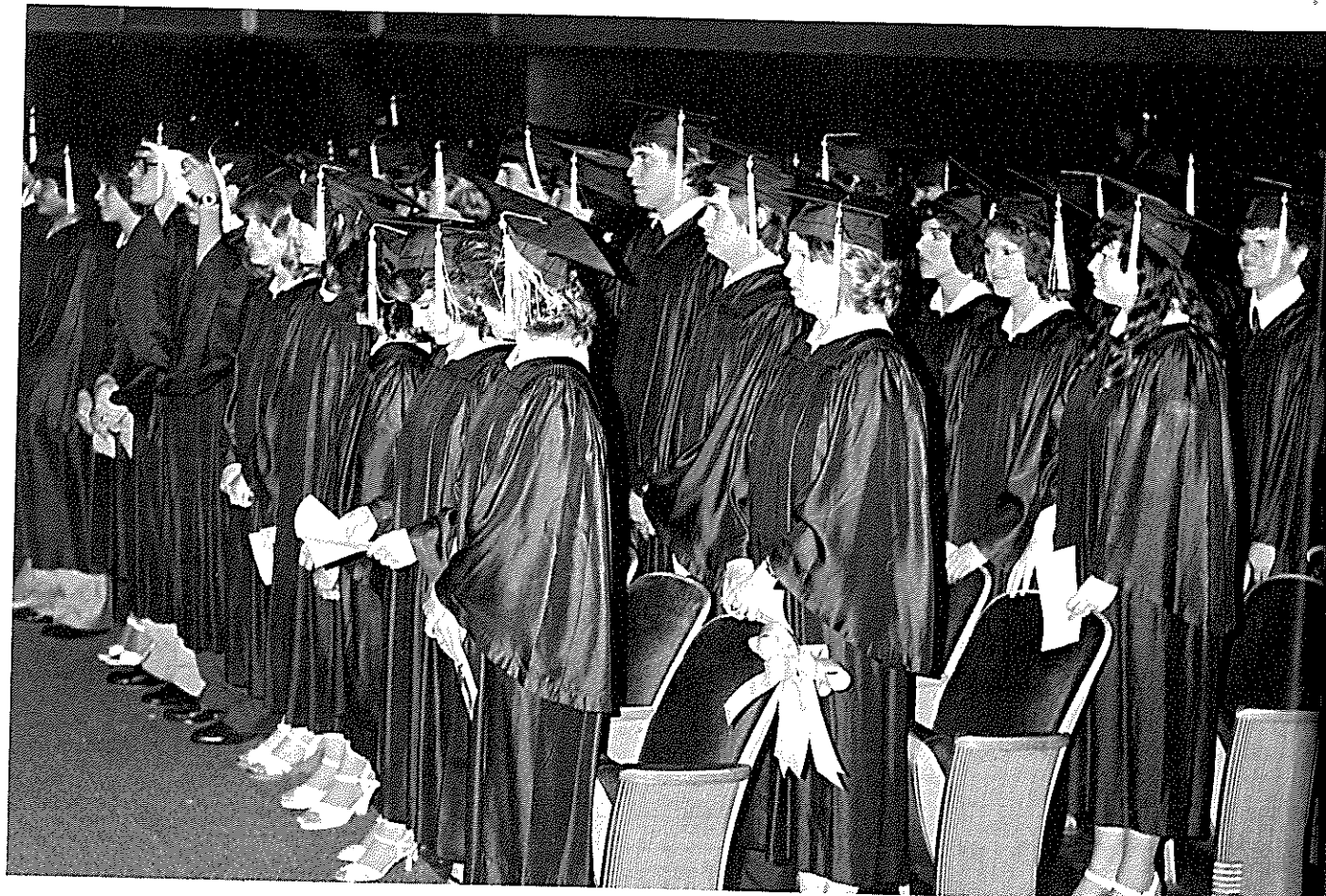


The End Of High School Arrives . . .

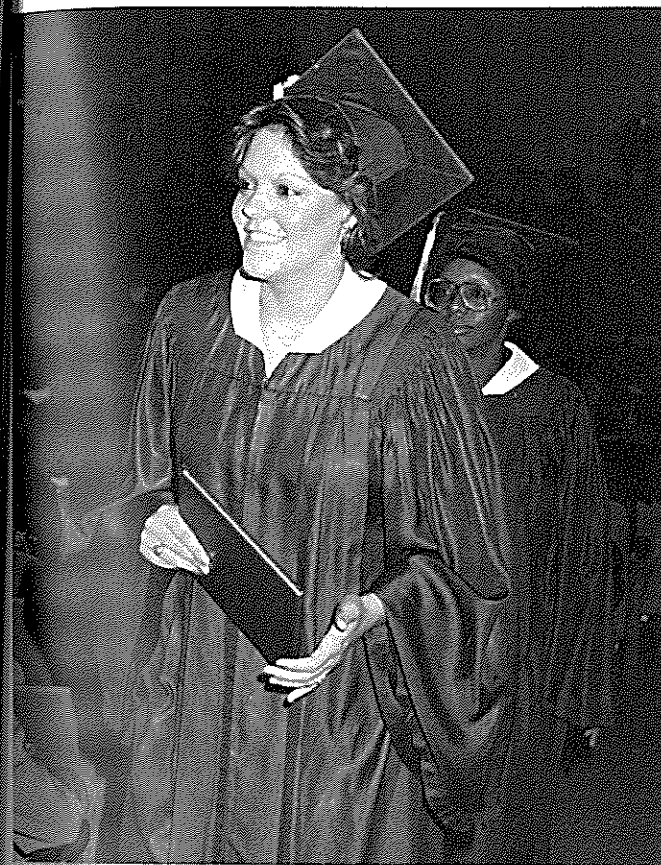

Todd Payne receives his diploma from W.J. (Bill) Mitchell, vice-president, KISD Board of Education.

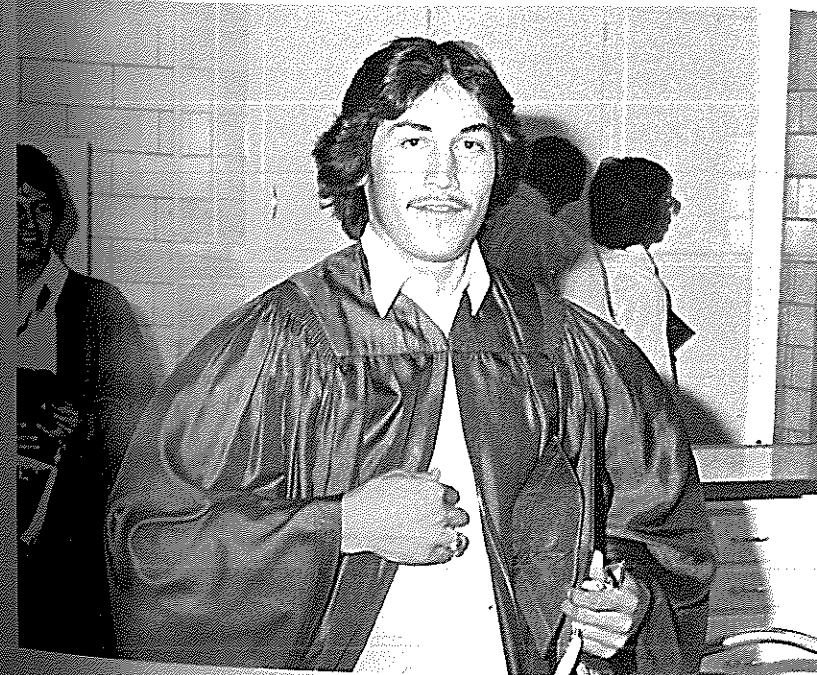


KISD Superintendent Johnnie Roberts congratulates Chris McKay and moves his tassel from right to left.
