
Loboes Fall To Kermit In Opener

The Kermit Yellow Jackets Opened the 1980-81 football season with a 12-7 victory over the Monahans Loboes.



Mike Gunter makes a big play against the Denver City Mustangs.


The KHS Yellow Jacket football squad continued its winning streak with an 8-0 victory over the Denver City Mustangs.

Jackets Sting Lovington, 39-7




In a clash with the Lovington Wildcats KHS quarterback David Fulbright runs the option.
