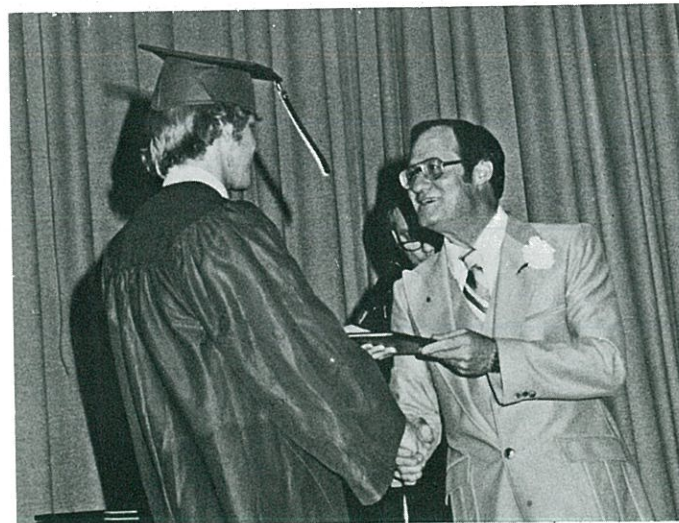


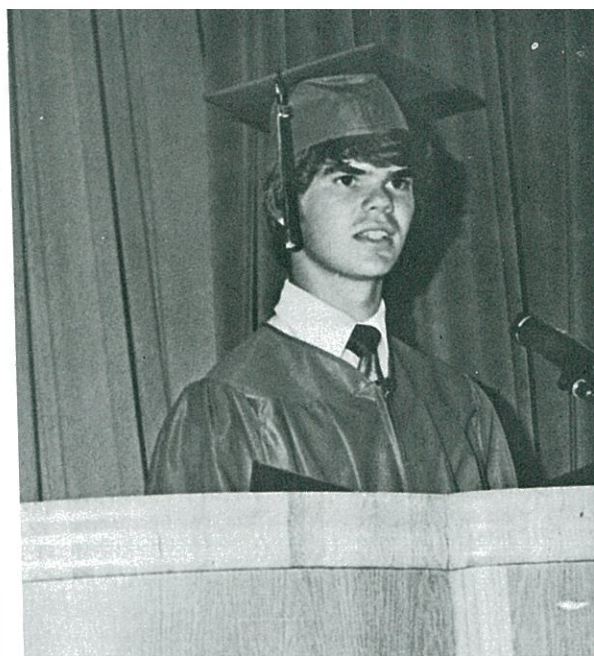
# We've Only Just Begun ... To Live
