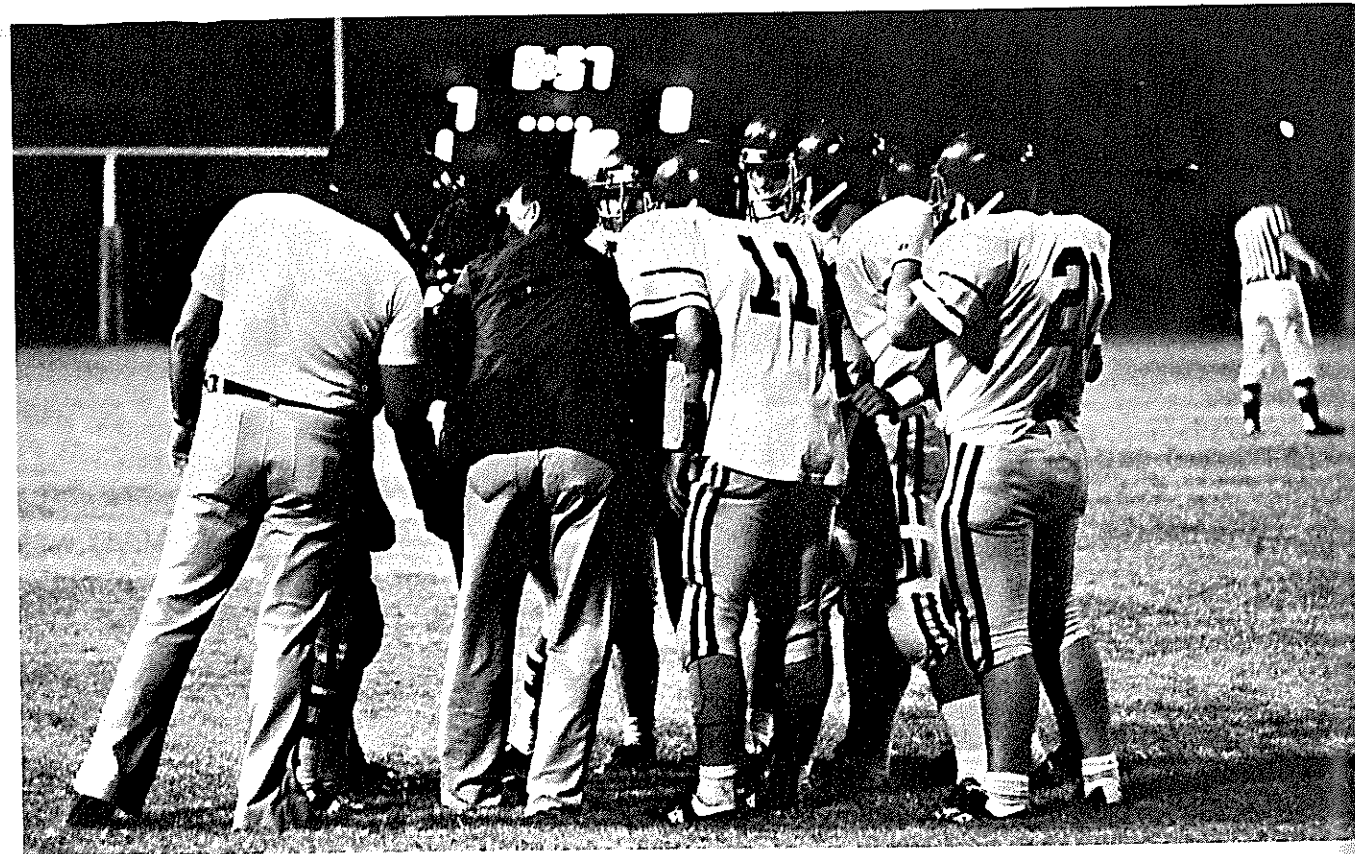


Jackets Rip Wildcats, Indians, Mustangs

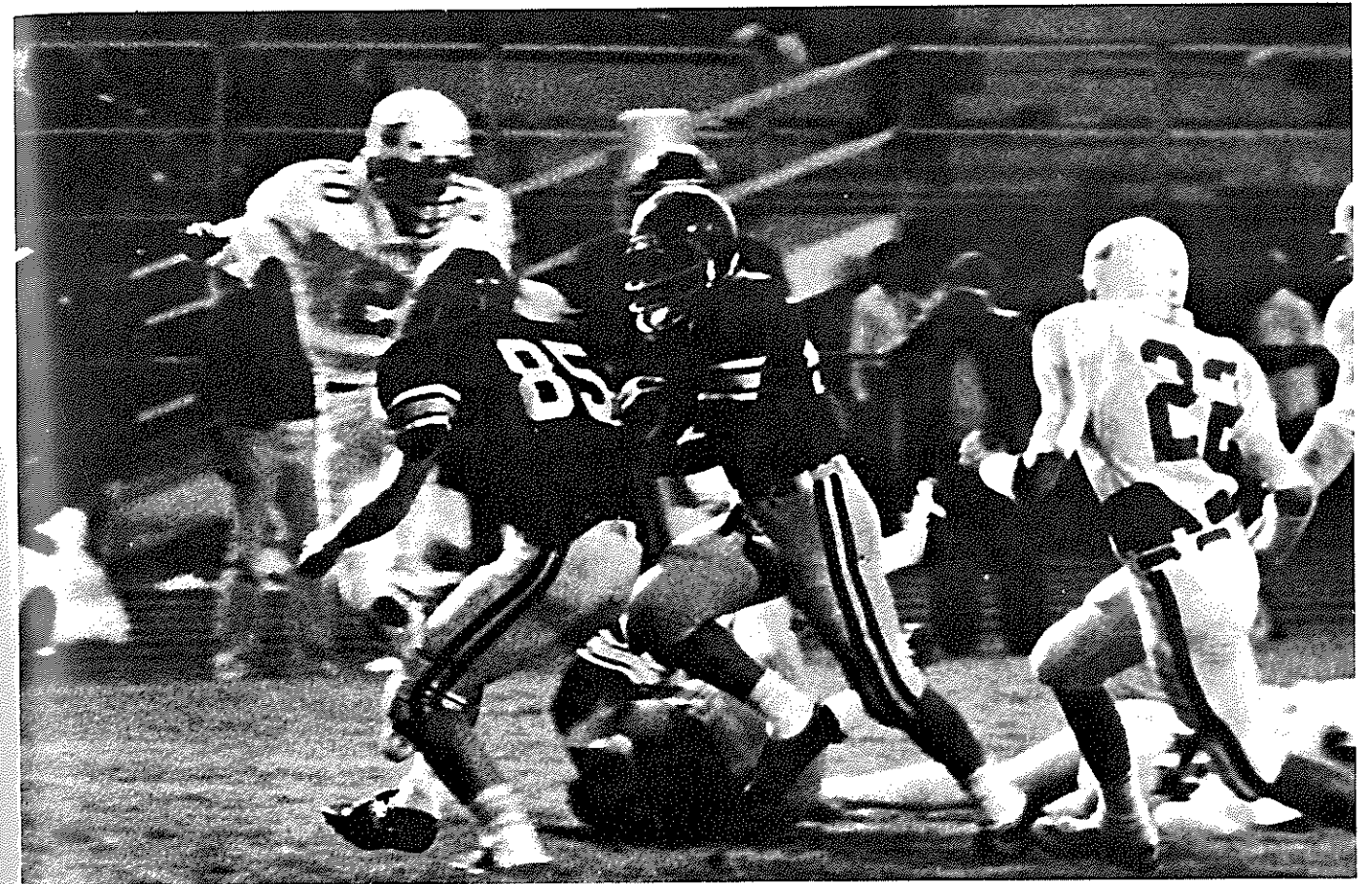
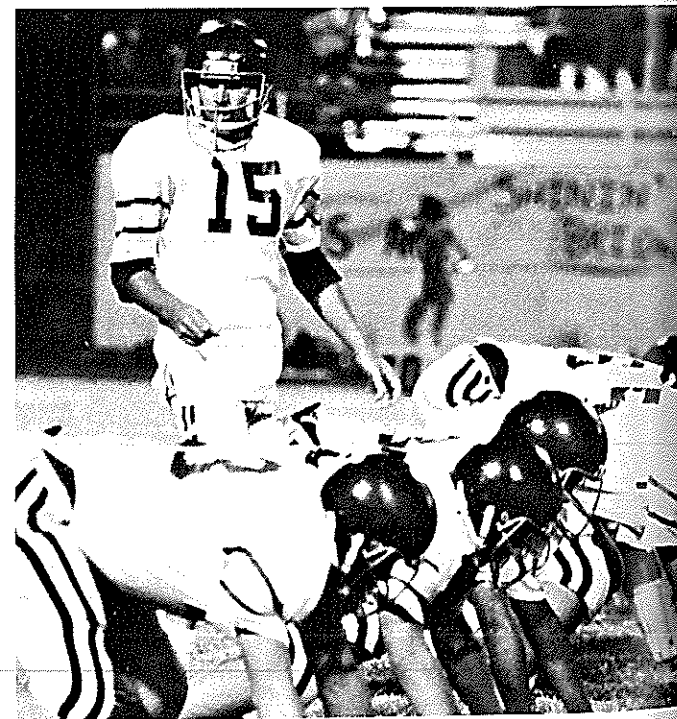


The Yellow Jackets plan their final strategy against Seminole.
