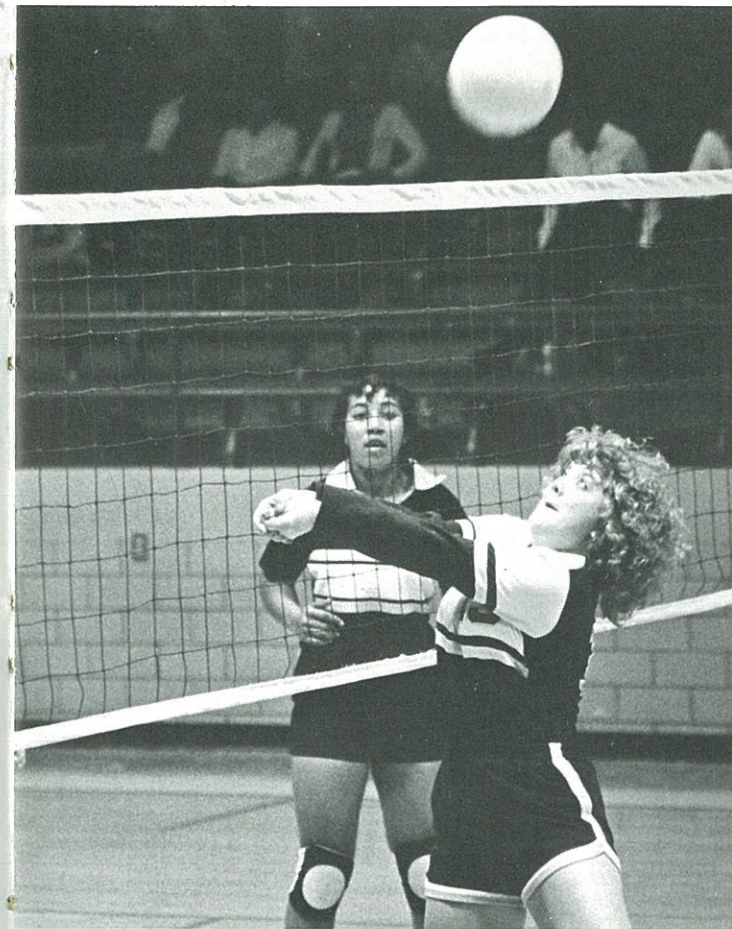
The KHS squad participated in three tournaments during the season: Monahans, San Angelo and Denver City.

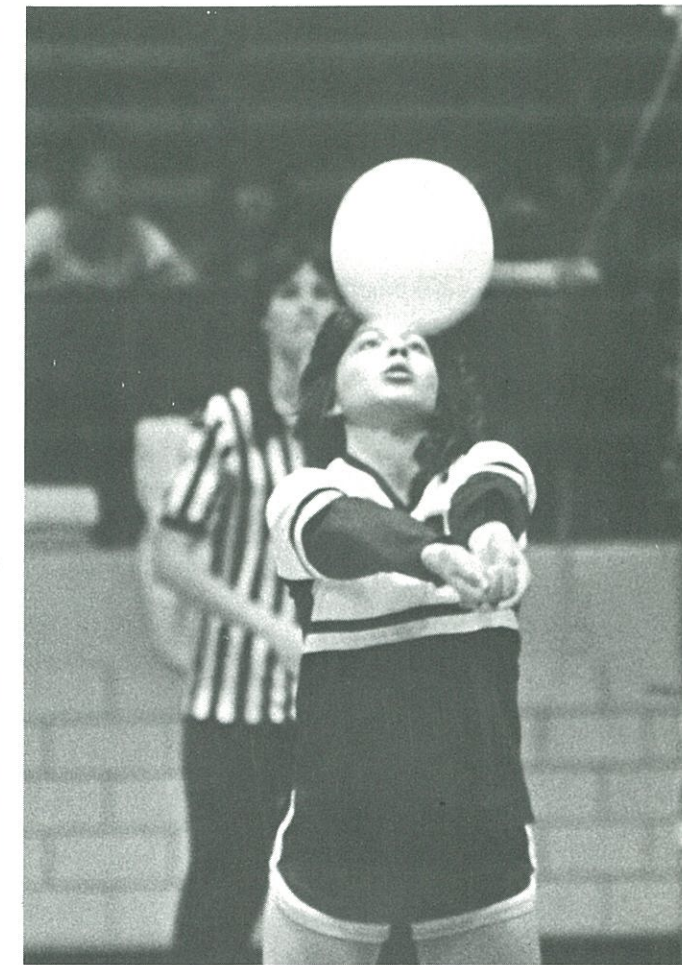

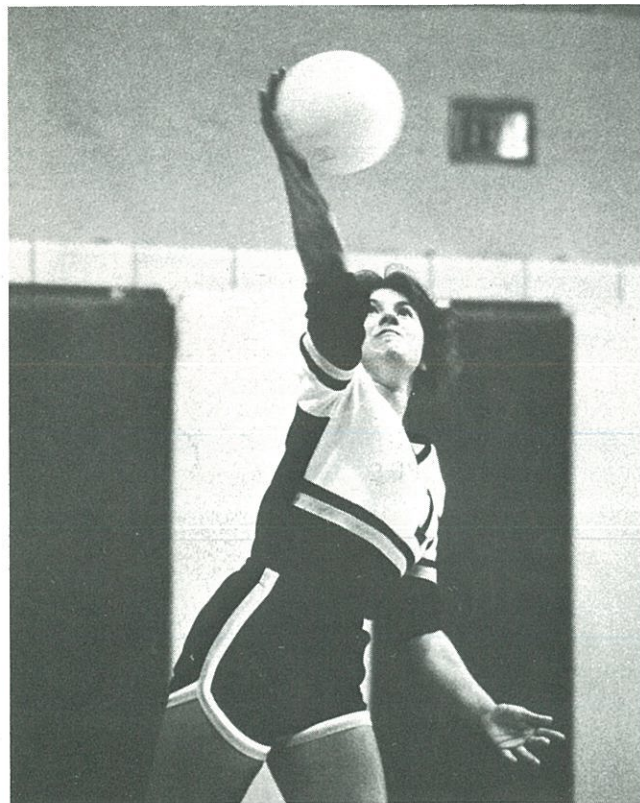
Setting the ball for the Yellow Jackets is Wendy McKay.
