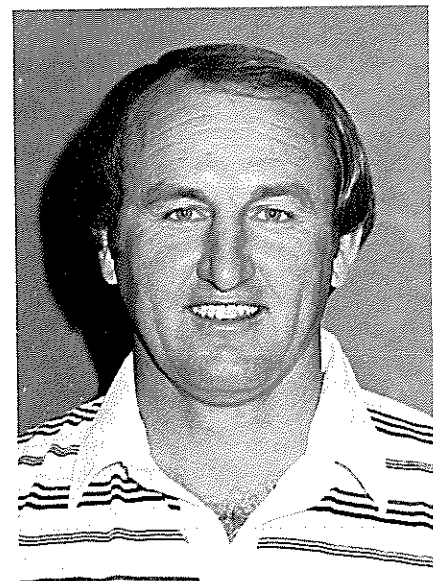


JV Boys Hit The Clubs Again
