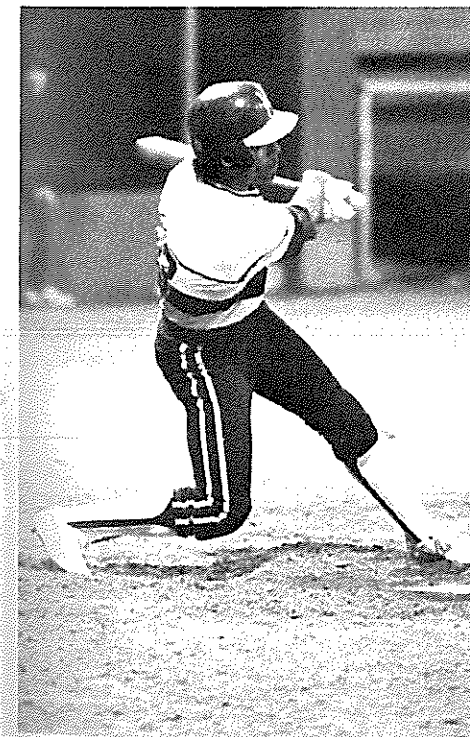
Jacket Sluggers Advance To Bi-District

The KHS crew ended the regular season with victories over every opponent, but lost one game to Alpine in Kokernot Stadium to finish in second place.

The Jackets then battled the Fabens Wildcats in Van Horn and lost 10-3.

Overall the maroon-and-gold squad lost several games, but won more than they lost. A large number of their losses were not against AAA ball clubs, but were against AAAAA and even AAAAAA squads in Texas as well as the state qualifier for New Mexico.
