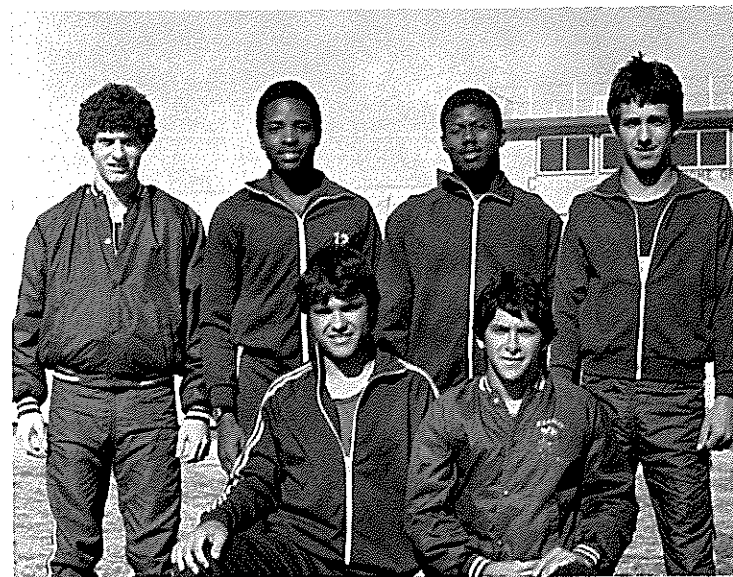


Running's The Name Of The Game
