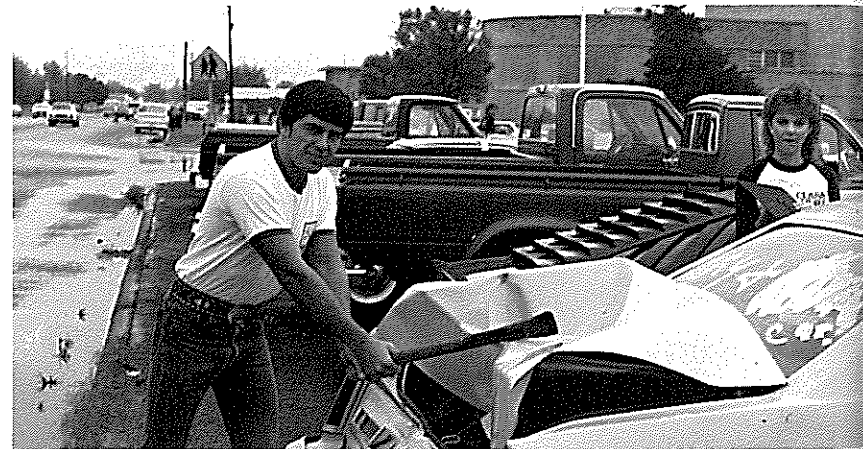


## Life For Students In Kermit Continues Outside The Classroom

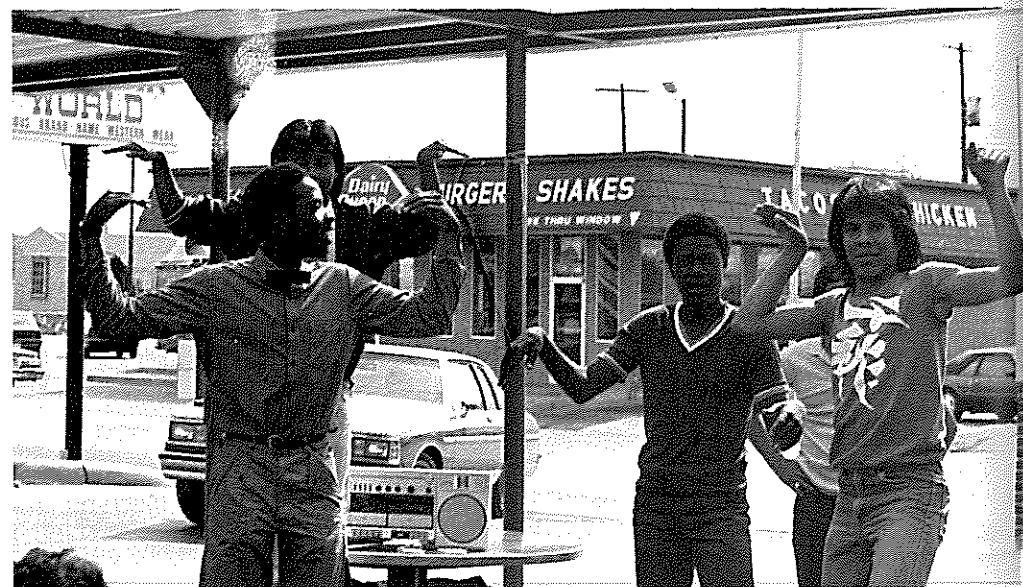


When not busy at school with assignments or classwork, Mike Glander uses his time with one special girl . . . or sometimes goes out to work — taking care of equipment and horses.

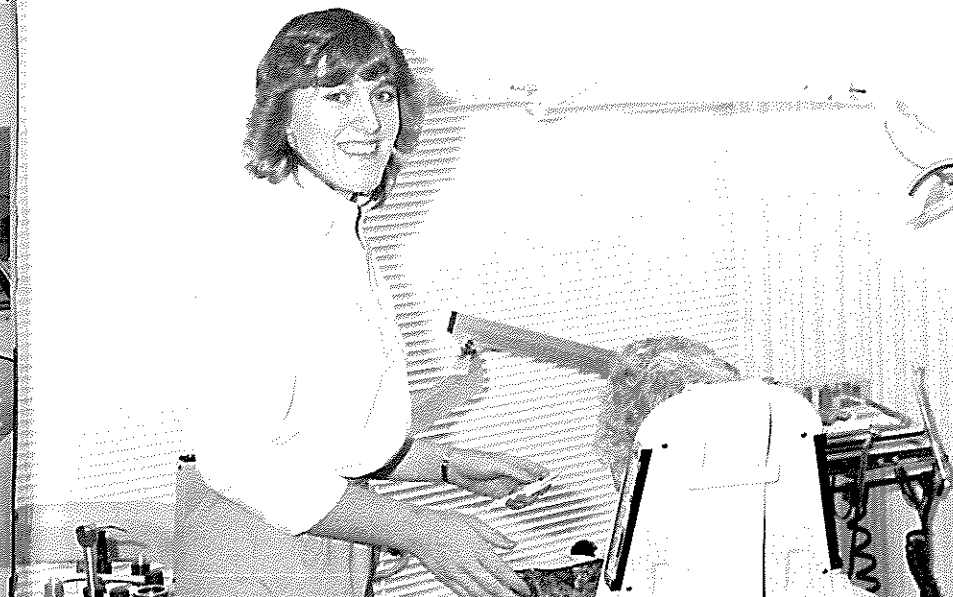
What is he doing? Todd Henderson seems bent on destroying the rear of someone's Ford.
