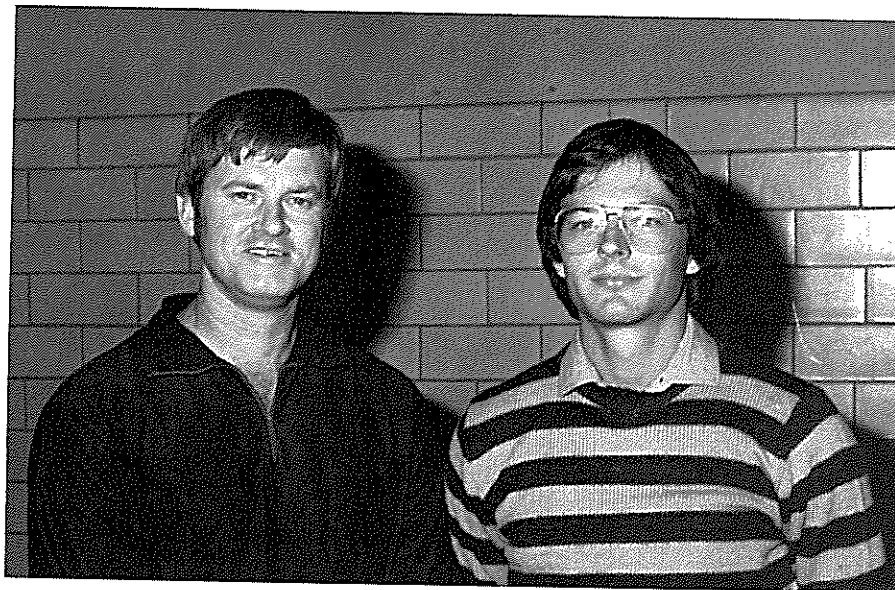
Fellowship Of Christian Athletes

FCA schedules activities throughout the year and some include dinners, weekly meetings and trips.

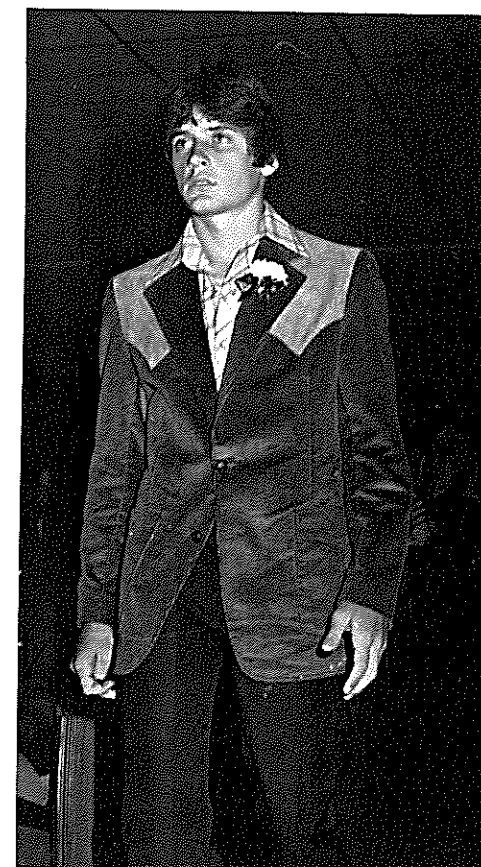
