
## Jackets Win District, 10-0 Record


Defensive tackle Billy Johnson (70) drops the Crane quarterback as the Jackets met the Golden Cranes in Bi-District action.

The Kermit varsity gridiron football squad challenged the Alpine Bucks in the last District 5-AAA game of the 1983 season and defeated the Bucks 14-0.



The Jackets drove down to the Crane four-yard line, but couldn't get into the endzone.


