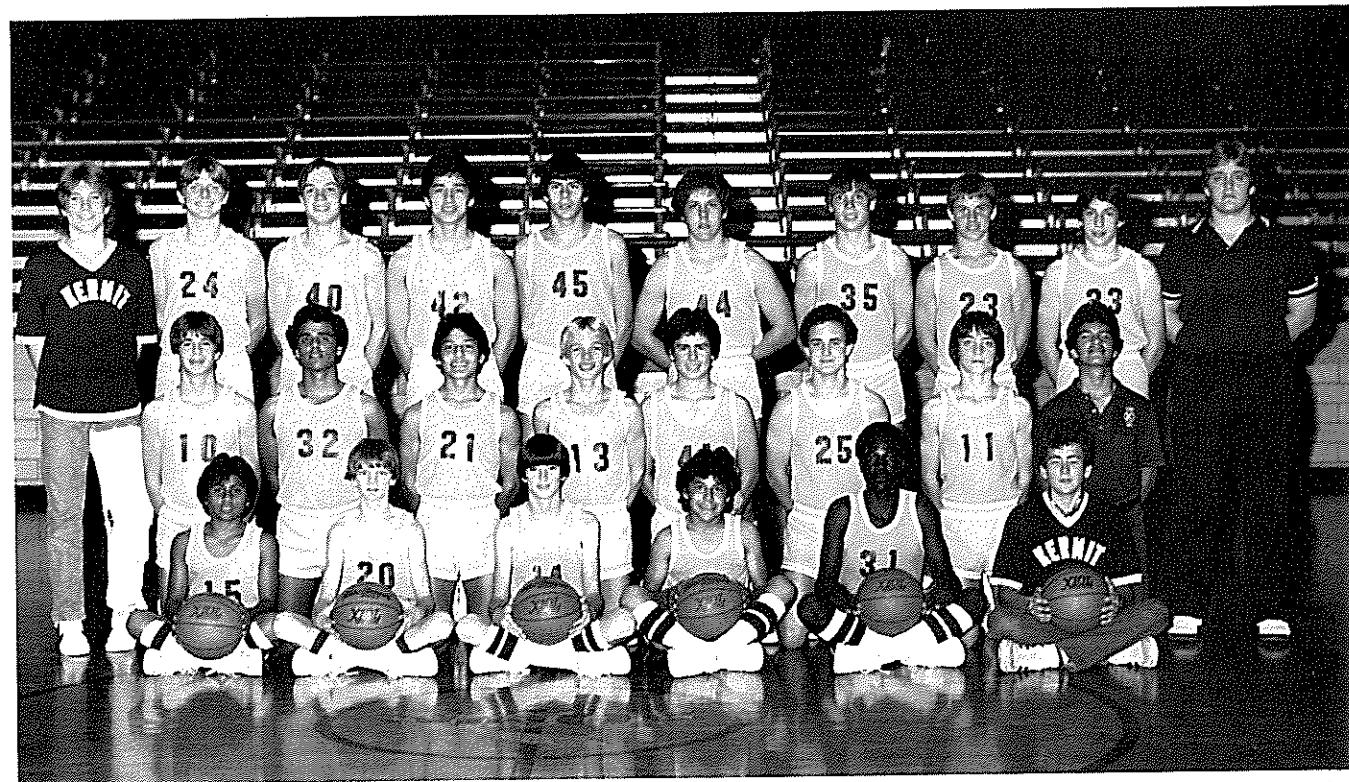
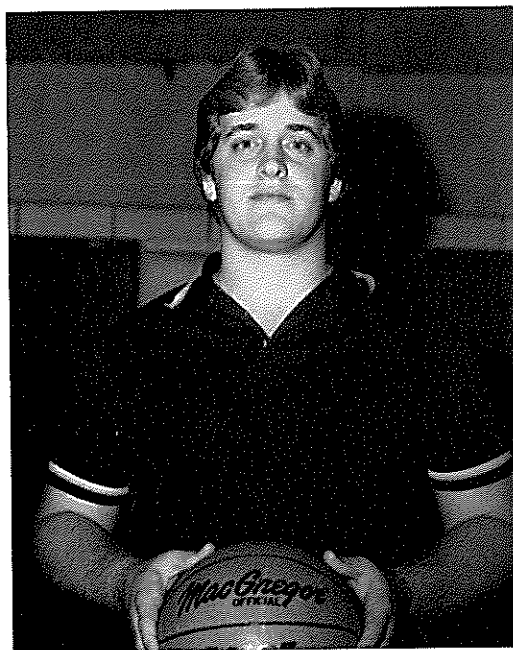


Freshmen Cagers Are Winners



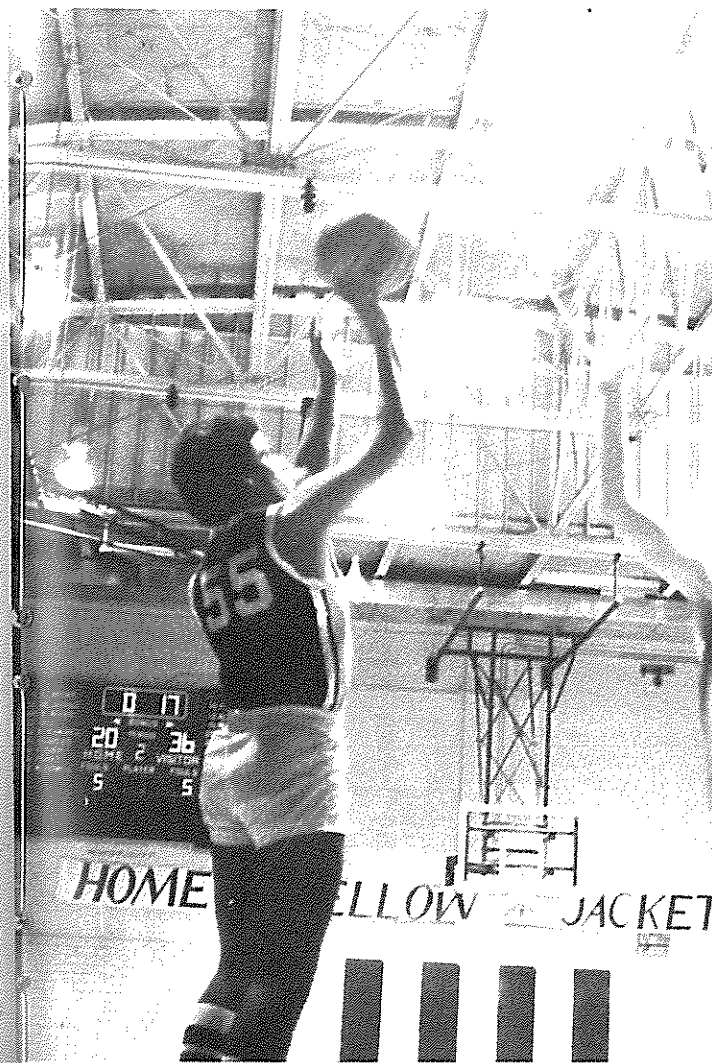

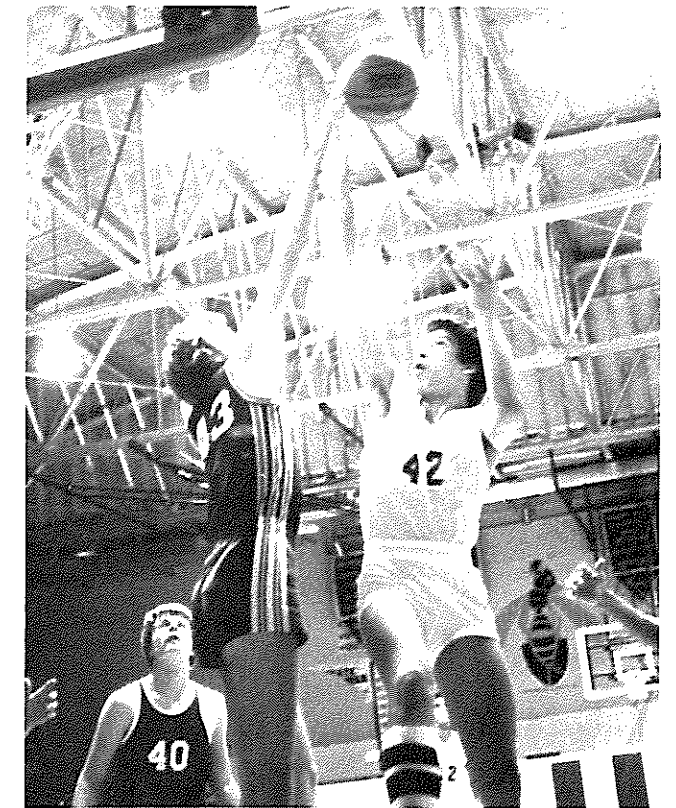

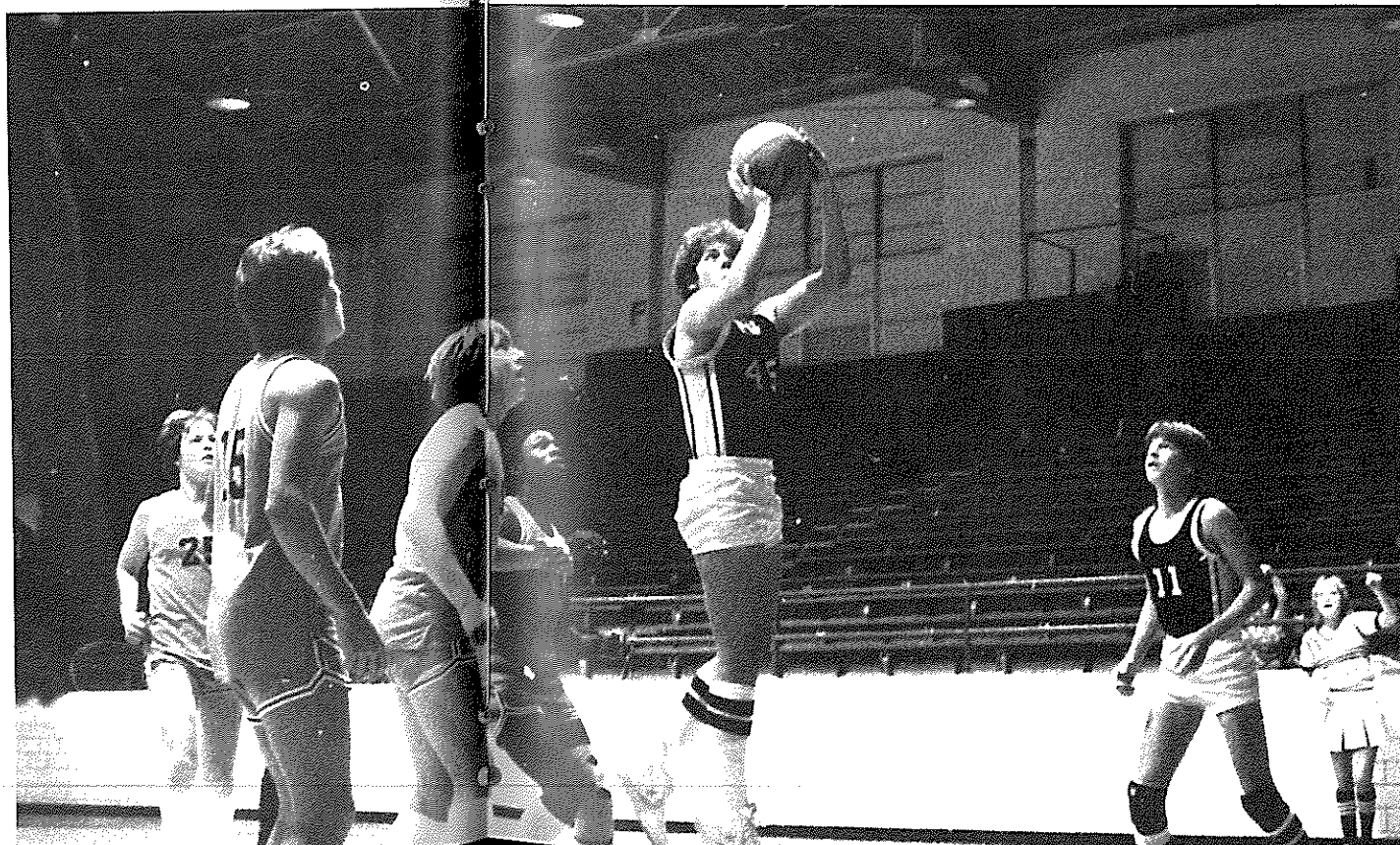
