

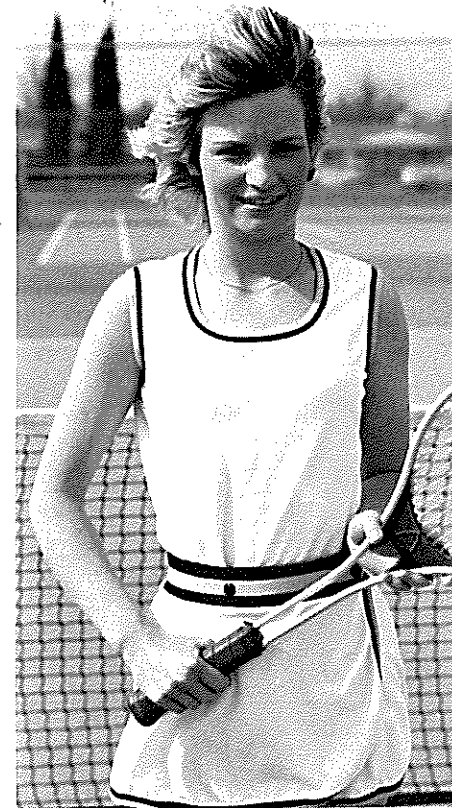
## Tennis Squad Thrives On Enthusiasm, Competition

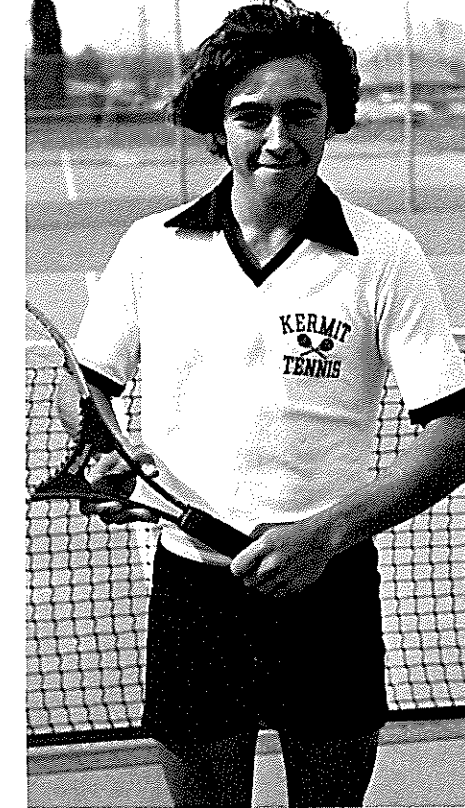

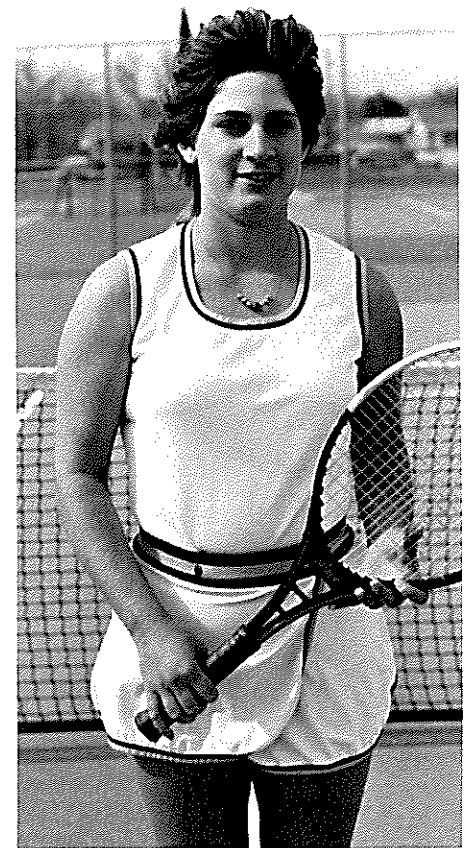

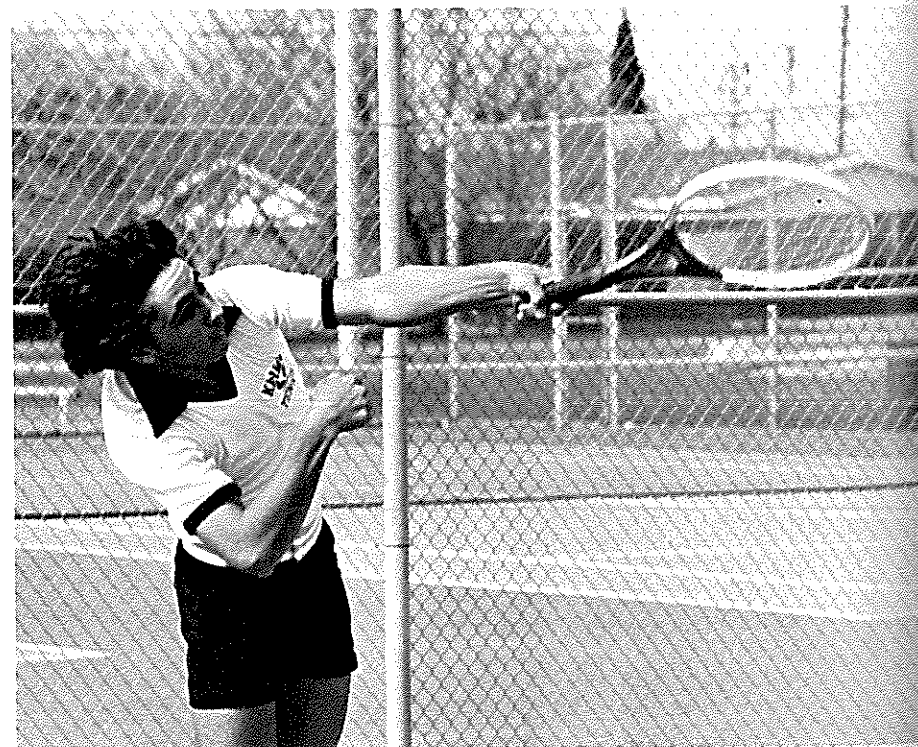
