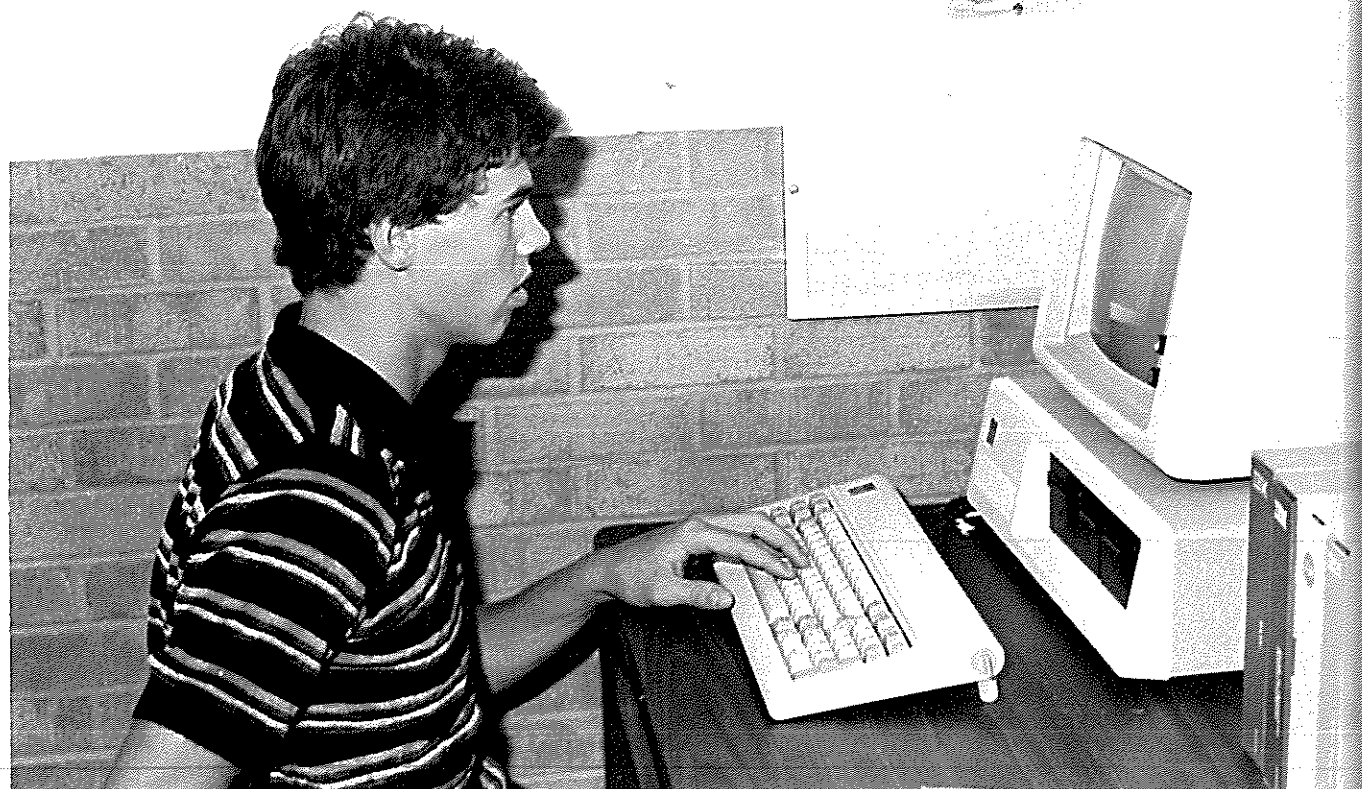

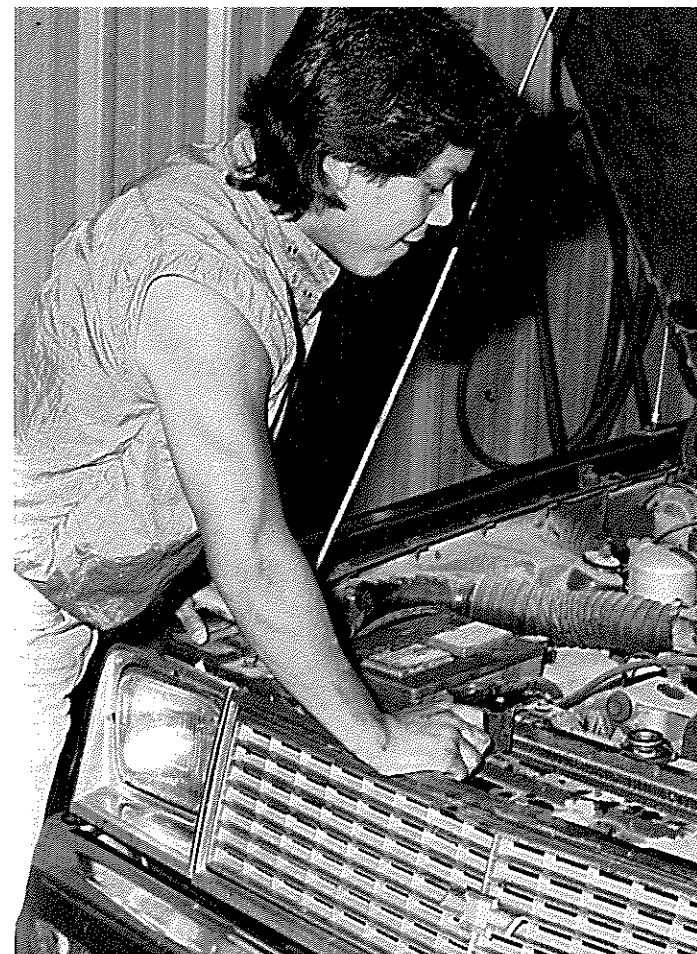
Junior Tony Ferrante and his typing class really seem to be enjoying themselves. Perhaps it isn't so bad after all.



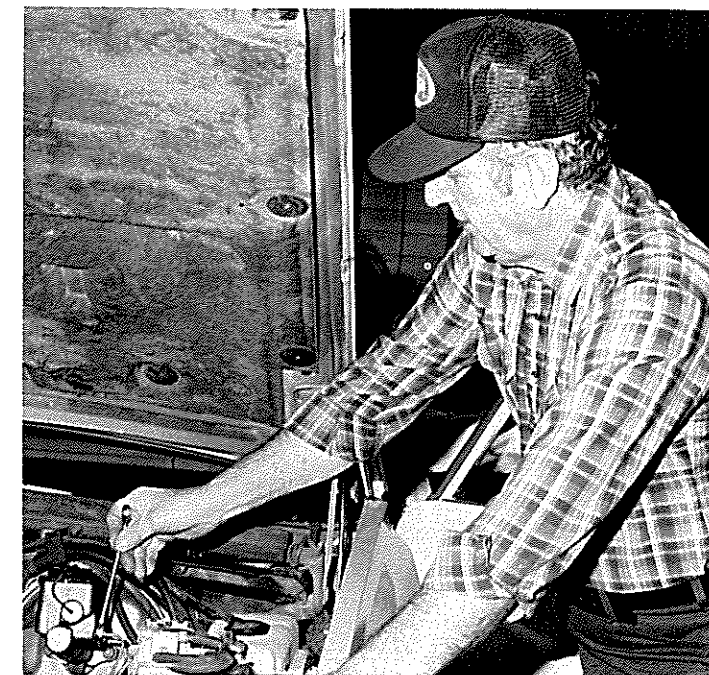
One of the more popular business classes during 1985 was computer programming. Here Ernest Jones is shown working on one of the IBM computers.
