





8th Dauber Cagers Are Winners


Marc Parks goes up for a three-point play as he is fouled on his jump shot. The Daubers held on to win over visiting Wink Wildkittens.

Going in for a lay-up and two sure points against the visiting Pecos eighth grade squad is Victor Muniz.










Going up for a two-point jump shot is Dauber cager Hector Lopez. Phil Todd adds two more points to the eighth Dauber basketball score.
