vided leadership for their class as well as the student body.

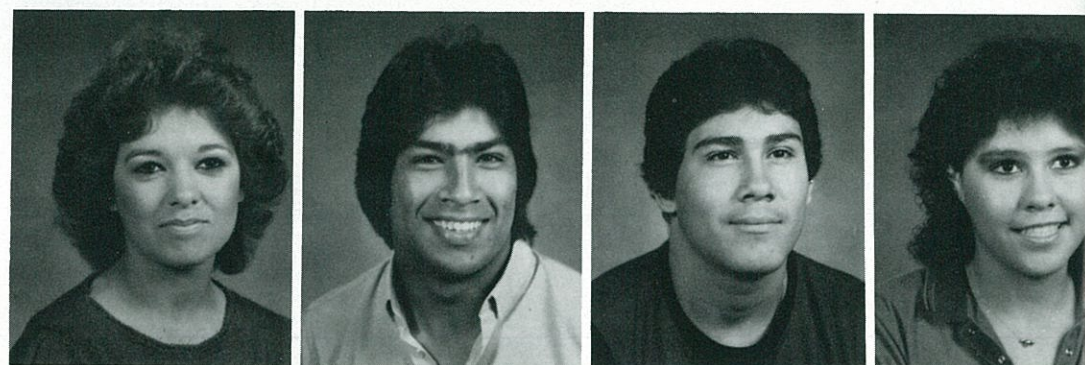
The juniors can very well consider this year a successful one. They won both annual High School Bowls ... yes, even defeating the seniors! A large number of juniors competed in

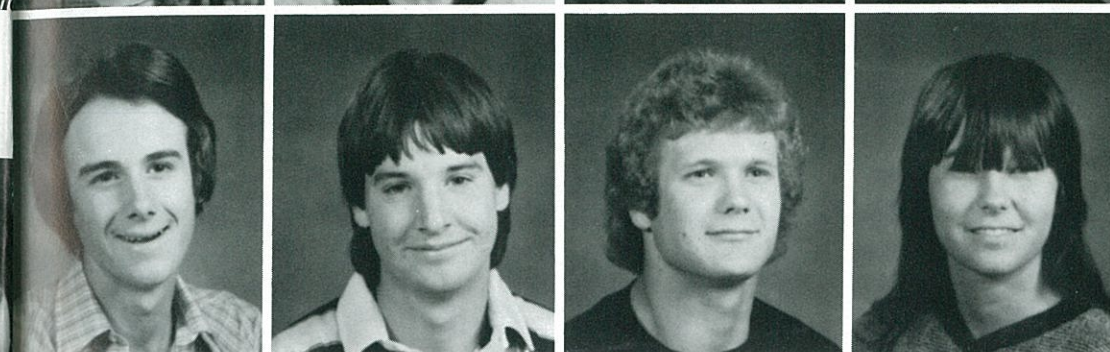


Serving as class officers for the Junior Class of 1985 were President Kent Ford, vice president Mike Langston and secretary Carrie Kapka.

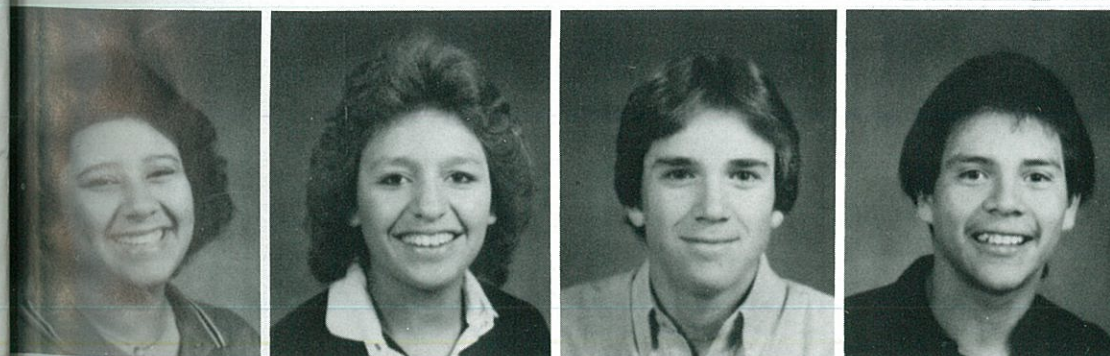
