Immediately after a yellow flag thrown for some unknown reason, Coach Earl Overton had a few selected words for a couple of officials ... much to the delight of the home spectators.

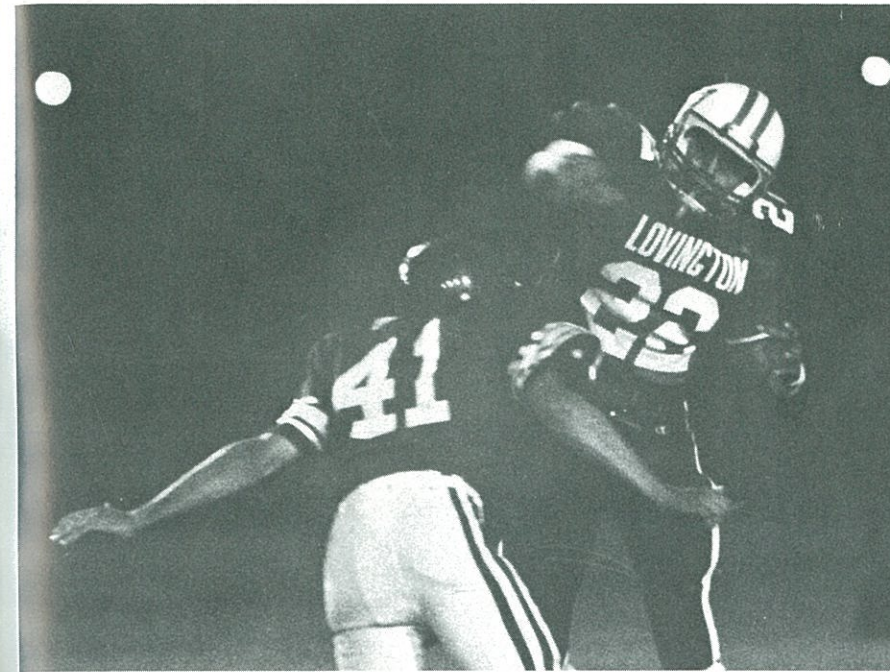
# Jackets Beat Slaton 41-7
