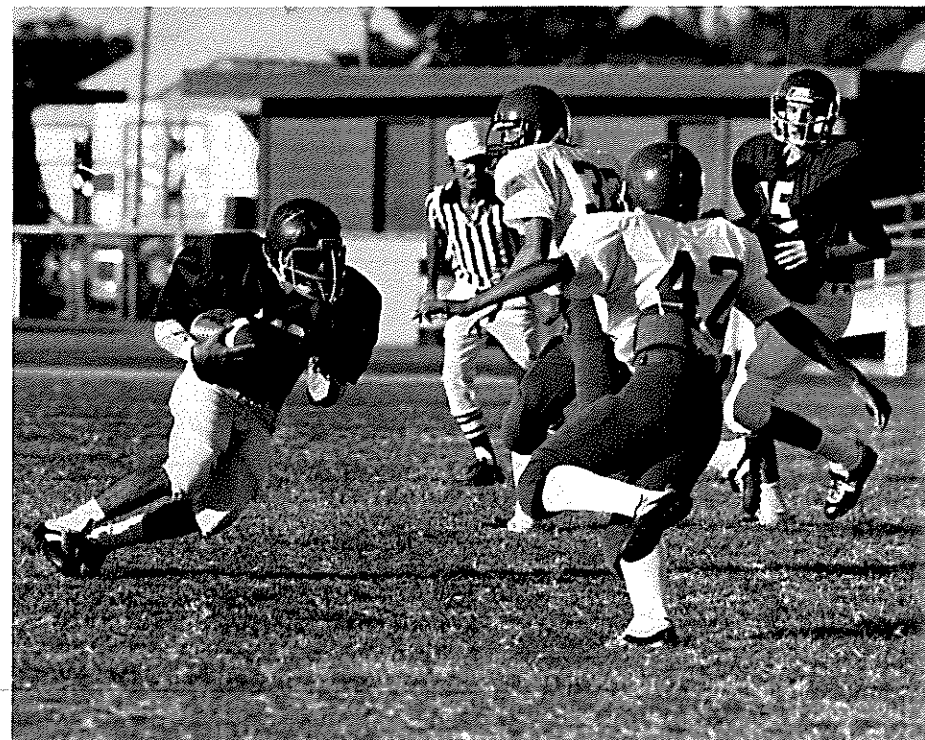


Freshmen Sharpen Gridiron Skills
