

Yellow Jackets Play Volleyball



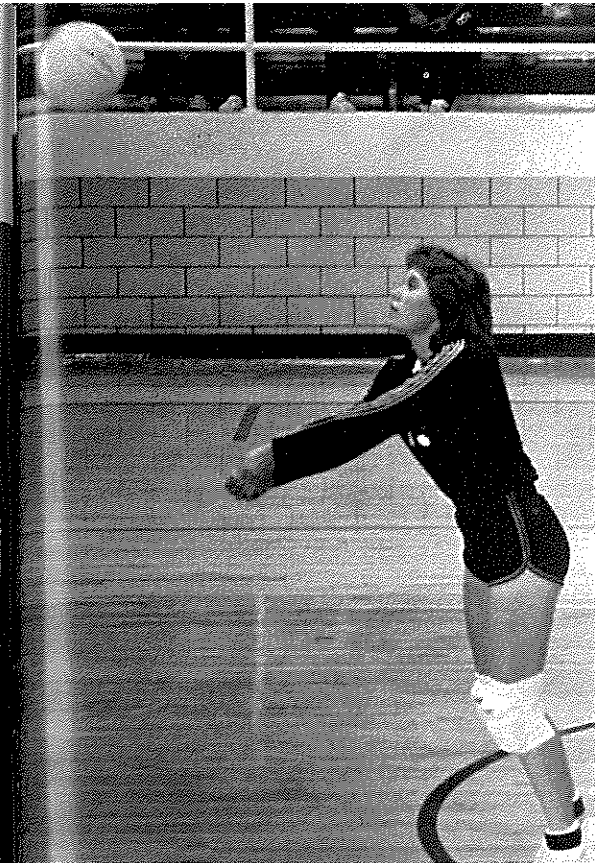

"The strength of this team lay in its ability to work together," said Coach Lee Lentz.

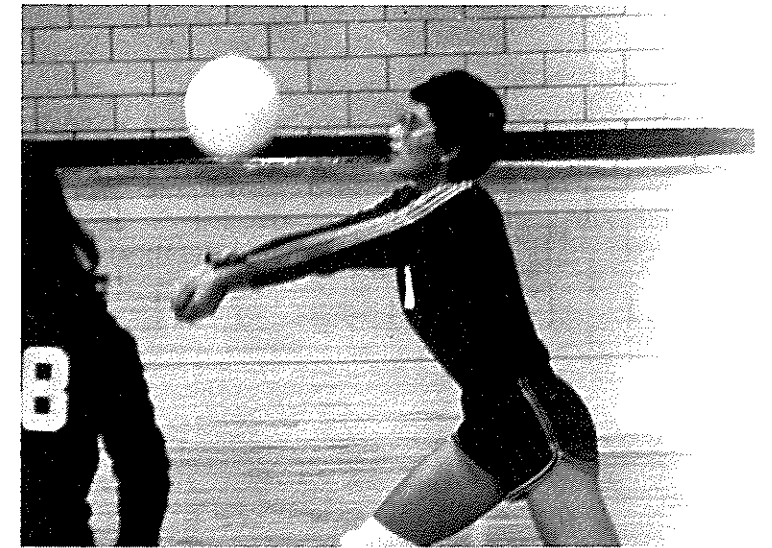

Shown doing her part in varsity action is sophomore Sandra Rivera, who was always there when needed.

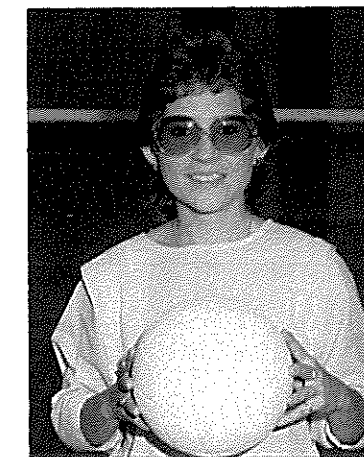
