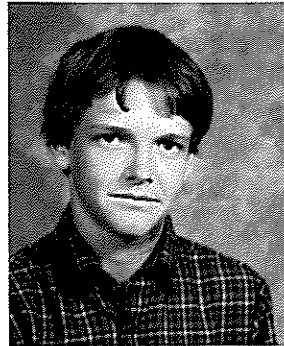

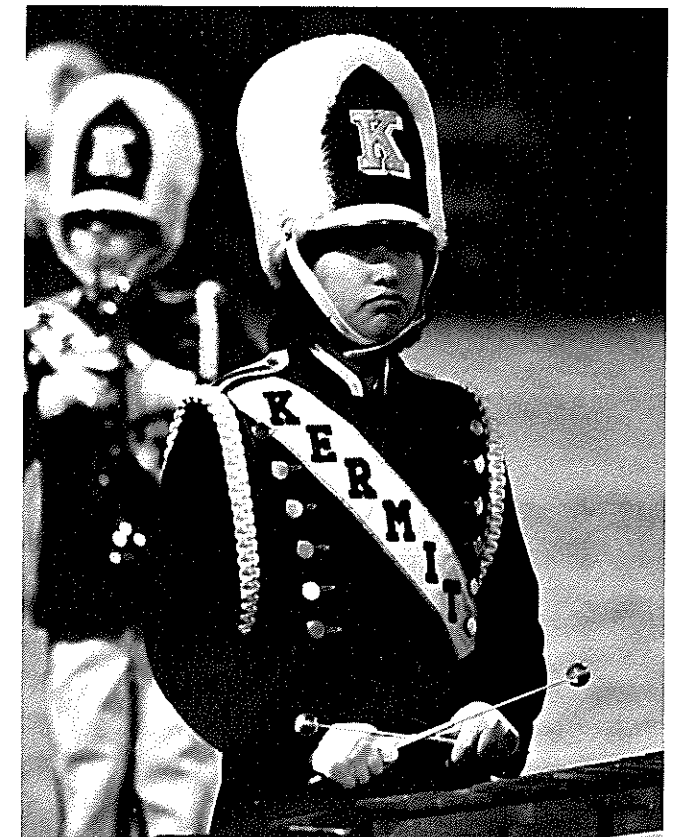
Yokko also came to "love" Mexican food ... but still believed that West Texas could use more trees.
