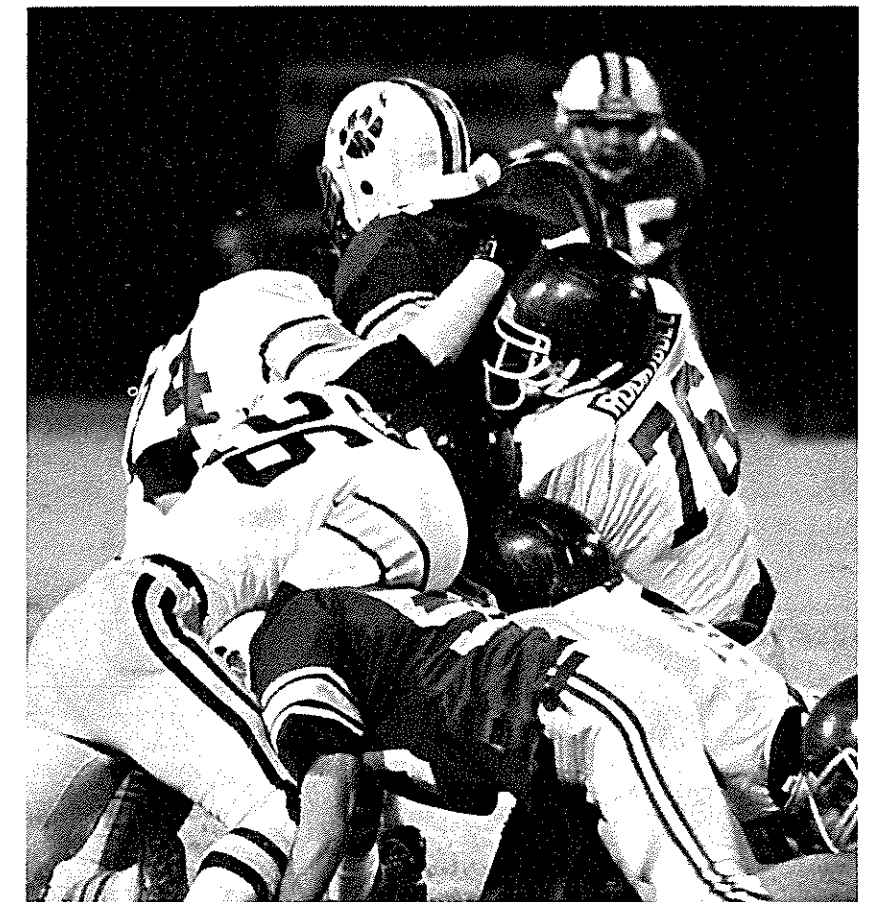
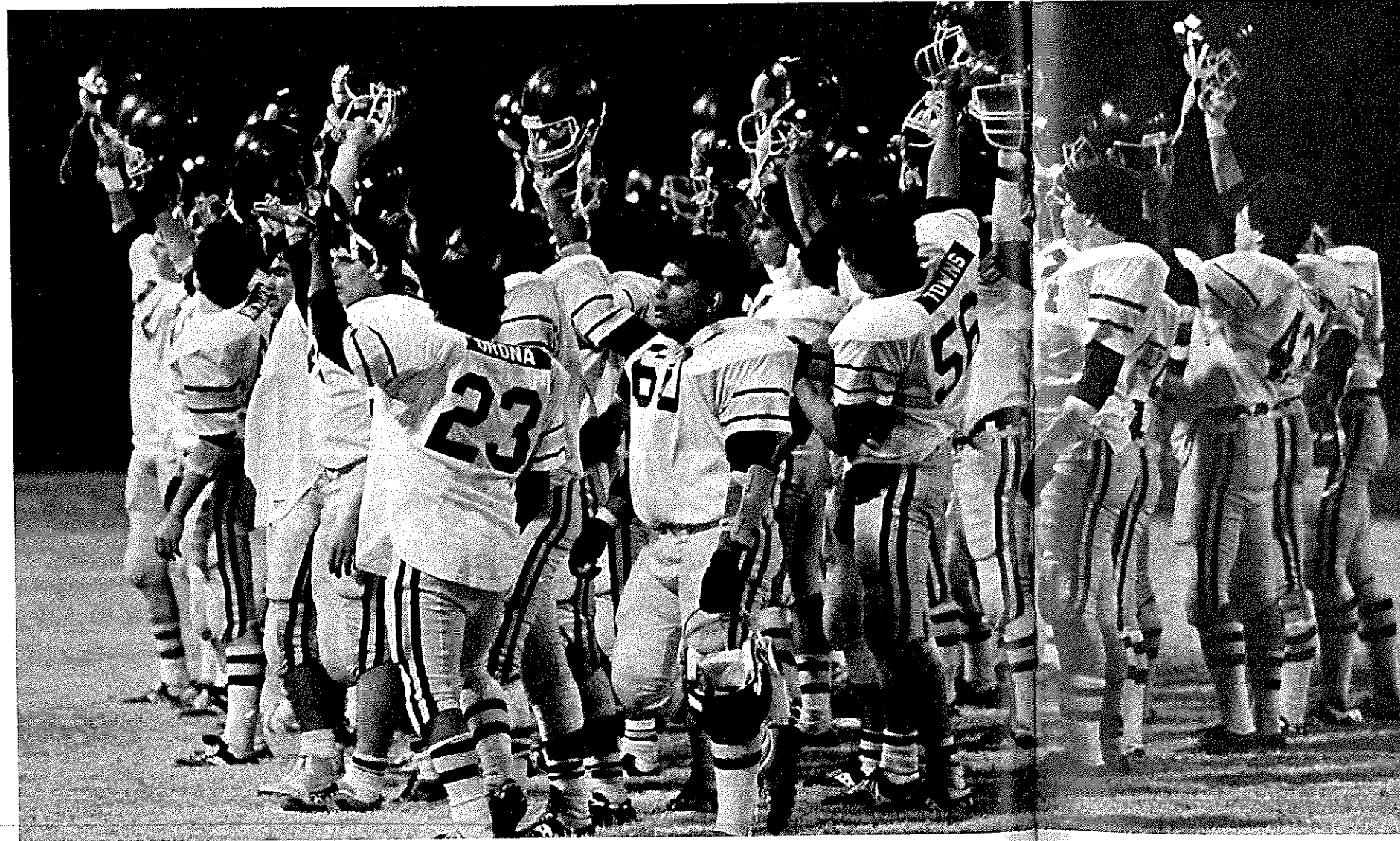
"This is a real fine group of kids and they worked hard from off-season last year up to the present," Coach Overton said. As coaches, we couldn't ask for a more committed group of young men."
